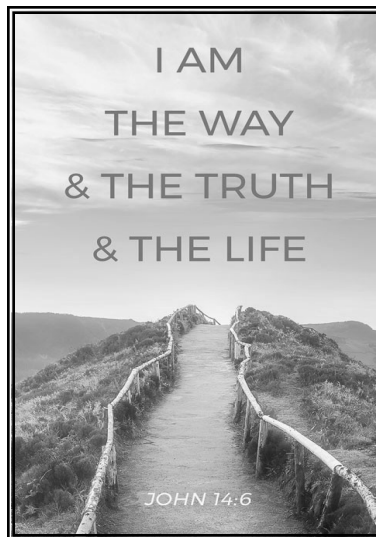

Estimados feligreses,

Hoy escuchamos a Josué proclamar frente a los israelitas muy desobedientes: "Yo y mi casa serviremos al Señor". Josue está listo para comenzar un viaje espiritual, deseando acercarse cada vez más a Dios haciendo Su voluntad y viviendo su vocación. Para él, no importa lo que elijan los demás: él sabe lo que Dios le pide y desea hacerlo. Está listo para comenzar su viaje espiritual al servicio del Señor.

Durante los dos últimos domingos hemos estado escuchando y hablando sobre nuestros propios viajes espirituales. Durante los próximos dos meses, echaremos un vistazo al mapa del viaje de nuestra alma hacia Dios: dónde comenzamos, las dificultades y el final que Dios tiene en mente para nosotros. Utilizaremos especialmente la obra de Santa Teresa de Ávila, "El castillo interior". Aquí describe el viaje espiritual, no como un viaje hacia el exterior, sino como un viaje dentro de nosotros mismos para descubrir a Dios que está más cerca de nosotros que nosotros mismos. Ella describe el alma como una morada cristalina donde Dios habita en el centro y ella divide el alma en siete mansiones. Estas siete mansiones, o moradas, representan las diferentes etapas del viaje espiritual, desde estar atrapado en el pecado hasta estar completamente unido a Dios.

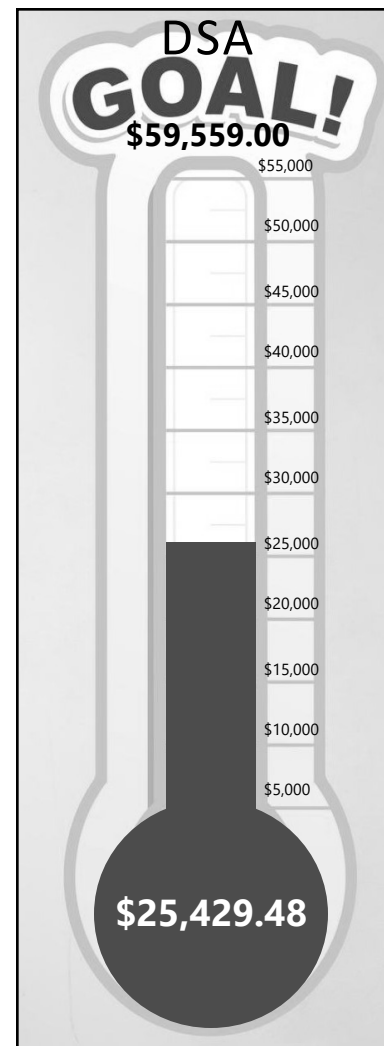
Antes incluso de llegar a la primera mansión, antes incluso de entrar en el alma para buscar a Dios, Santa Teresa asume dos cosas. La primera es que estamos dispuestos a emprender este viaje hacia Dios dentro de nosotros y la segunda es que estamos orando. Todo de lo que hablaremos durante los próximos dos meses será inútil si no estamos dispuestos a emprender nuestro propio viaje espiritual interno hacia Dios y ser personas que hablen con Dios a diario. Esta es una expectativa básica para ella y para todos nosotros en San Roberto. Debemos estar listos para crecer en nuestros viajes espirituales y ser personas de oración. Entonces, ¿estoy listo para emprender un viaje espiritual y descubrir a Dios que ya está dentro de mí, pero cubierto por mi pecado? Rezo para que todos recibamos la gracia que Dios ya nos ha dado y digamos: "¡Sí, en cuanto a mí y mi casa, serviremos al Señor!" Crearé en santidad y comenzaré mi viaje espiritual. Me convertiré en la persona que Dios me ha creado ser. Por la gracia de Dios, me esforzaré por ser santo junto con los miembros de mi familia.

Después de tomar esta decisión, debemos mirar nuestra vida de oración. No podemos decir que vamos a servir al Señor y luego no escucharlo, así que debemos preguntarnos: "¿Tengo tiempo reservado cada día para hablar sinceramente con el Señor?" A esto lo llamamos oración. ¿Escucho a Dios hablando dentro de mí o solo le hablo a Él? ¿Utilizo la Biblia para encontrarme con la Palabra de Dios y conocer Su voluntad para mi vida? ¿Quiero hacer la voluntad de Dios? Todas estas son preguntas que debemos hacernos antes de comenzar este viaje espiritual. Para ser honesto, a la mayoría de las personas no les importa su relación con Dios, y ciertamente no hemos invertido mucho tiempo y energía en ello. Sin embargo, podemos mirar el ejemplo de Josué hoy y decir con él: "En cuanto a mí y mi casa, serviremos al Señor". Por la gracia de Dios, descubriremos a Dios dentro de nosotros. Seremos un pueblo de oración. emprende este viaje espiritual. Haremos la voluntad de Dios. Buscamos estar completamente unidos con Dios en mente, cuerpo y alma ". Esto es lo que significa servir al Señor, comenzar nuestro camino espiritual, ser personas de oración y ser santos.

BEREAVEMENT MINISTRY



Hi, my name is Vicky Soliz Limas and I will be the coordinator for St. Robert's Bereavement Ministry. I have lived in El Campo all my life and am the daughter of the late Juan and Josephine Soliz. I am the youngest of a family of 10 children. I was baptized and had all sacraments here at St. Roberts. I have 2 adult daughters, a great son in law and 3 amazing grandchildren. I am a member of St. Roberts Catholic Daughters and have been for about 27 years. I helped coordinate and assist with the Altar Servers when my girls served for 10 years. I have helped in various ways in the parish from festivals, to Children's Christmas Choirs, to working breakfast kitchens and being a servant at funerals for our parish families. I have coordinated Vacation Bible School for the last 26 years and am currently a lector. I currently serve on ACTS Core for the El Campo Deanery for our local ACTS Retreats. I am in my 30th year with El Campo ISD as the Secretary to the Superintendent. In all aspects of what I am involved in and my job, I love working with and helping people.

I recently stepped down from teaching Confirmation/CCD which I have done for the past 26 years. As they say when one door closes, another opens. I was not looking for that door, but when the holy spirit knocks, you answer and pray and seek what God's will is. We are beginning a new Bereavement Ministry here at St. Roberts that I am excited, yet scared and nervous about. By no means am I anyone to be in charge, but at the same time, after much discussion with Father, and MUCH prayer and discernment, and with a humble heart, I will facilitate this ministry here at our Parish. I lost my mother June 2, 2020 and though I know I was blessed with her 93 years of life, I felt a pain that I had never experienced before. I searched and researched all of these things I was feeling and all those experiencing grief will go through these feelings, which I learned are stages, and although no one experiences grief in the same way, the stages can be understood. Our prayer is that anyone who has lost a loved one, will join us and allow us to accompany you. The first meeting will be Friday, August 27th from 6:00-8:00 in the parish hall. Dear Parishioners,

Today we hear Joshua proclaim in front of the very disobedient Israelites, "As for me and my house, we will serve the Lord." Joshua is ready to begin a spiritual journey, desiring to grow ever closer to God by doing His will and living out his vocation. For him it does not matter what everyone else chooses - he knows what God is asking of him and desires to do it. He is ready to start his spiritual journey in serving the Lord.

For the past two Sundays we have been hearing and talking about our own spiritual journeys. Over the next two months we will take a look at the map of our soul's journey to God - where we start, the difficulties, and the end that God has in mind for us. We will especially be using St. Teresa of Avila's work, "The Interior Castle." Here she describes the spiritual journey, not as an outward journey, but a journey inside of ourselves in order to discover God who is closer to us than we are to ourselves. She describes the soul as a crystal clear dwelling place where God dwells at the center and she divides the soul up into seven mansions. These seven mansions, or dwelling places, represent the different stages in the spiritual journey, from being stuck in sin to being completely united with God.

Before we even get to the first mansion, before we even enter the soul to search for God, St. Teresa assumes two things. The first is that we are willing to go on this journey to God inside of ourselves and the second is that we are praying. Everything we will be talking about over the next two months will be useless if we are not willing to go on our own internal spiritual journey to God and to be people who speak with God on a daily basis. This is a basic expectation for her and for all of us at St. Robert's. We should be ready to grow on our spiritual journeys and be people of prayer. So, am I ready to go on a spiritual journey and discover God who is already within me, but covered up by my sinfulness? I pray that we all receive the grace that God has already given us and say "Yes, as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord!" I will grow in holiness and begin my spiritual journey. I will become the person God has created me to be. By God's grace I will strive to be a saint along with the members of my family.

After making this decision, then we must look at our lives of prayer. We cannot say that we are going to serve the Lord and then not listen to Him, so we must ask ourselves, "Do I have time set aside each day to speak sincerely with the Lord?" We call this prayer. Do I listen to God speaking within me or do I only talk at Him? Do I use the Bible to encounter God's Word and to know His will for my life? Do I want to do God's will? All of these are questions that we must ask ourselves before we begin this spiritual journey.

To be quite honest, most people don't care about their relationship with God, and we certainly haven't been investing a lot of time and energy into it. However, we can look to Joshua's example today and say with him, "As for me and my house, we will serve the Lord. We will, by God's grace, discover God within us. We will be a people of prayer. We will go on this spiritual journey. We will do God's will. We seek to be completely united with God in mind, body, and soul." This is what it means to serve the Lord, to begin our spiritual journey, to be people of prayer, and to be saints.
