

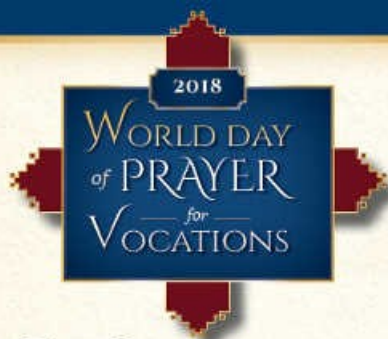

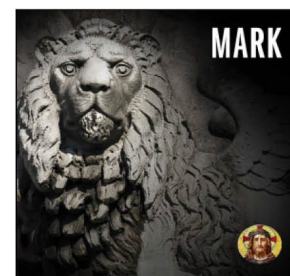

## Ministry to the Sick notes from Deacon Mike:

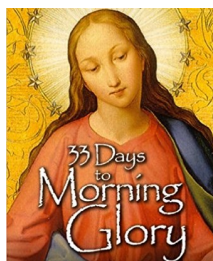
Called to *Serve*
