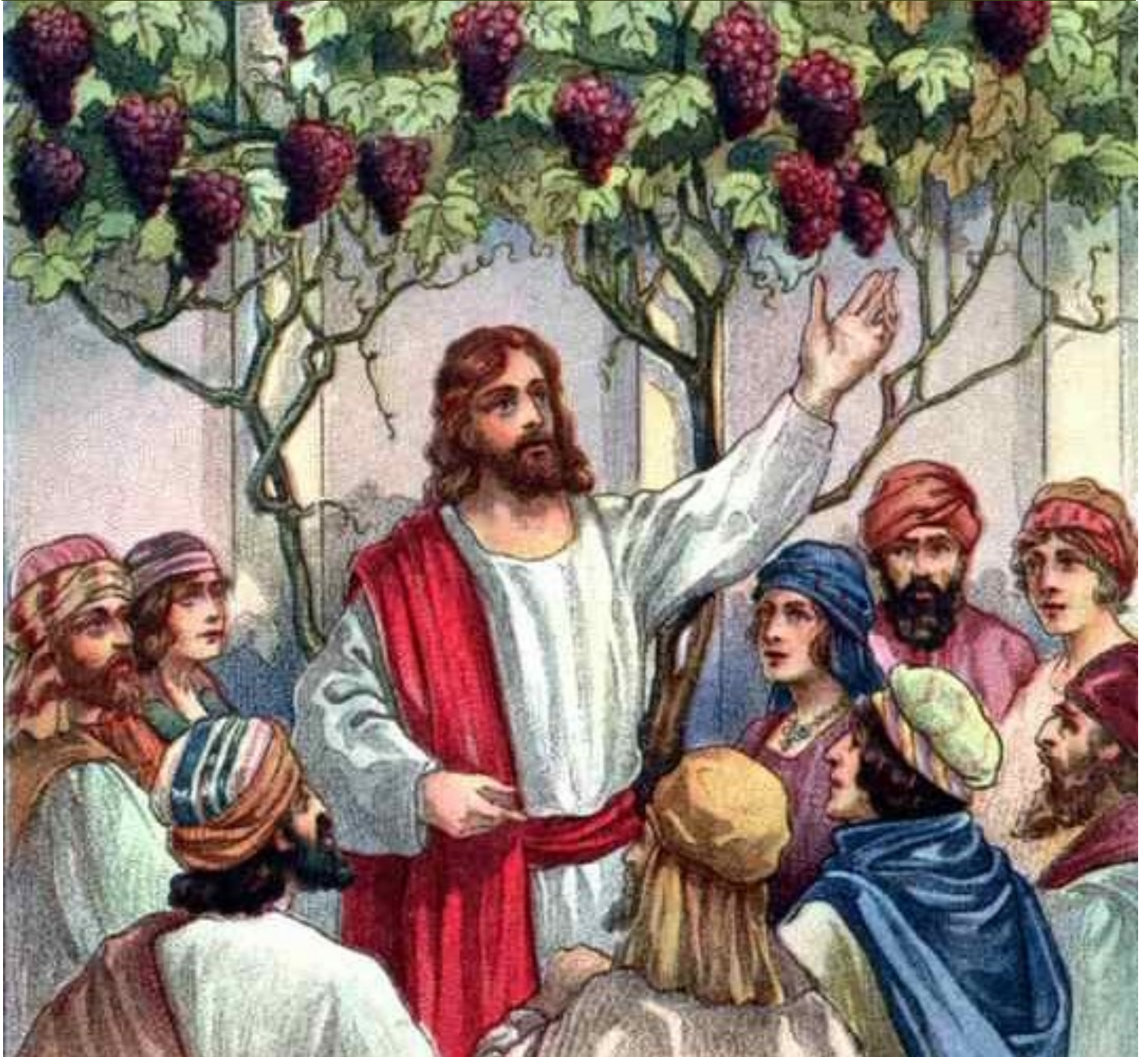

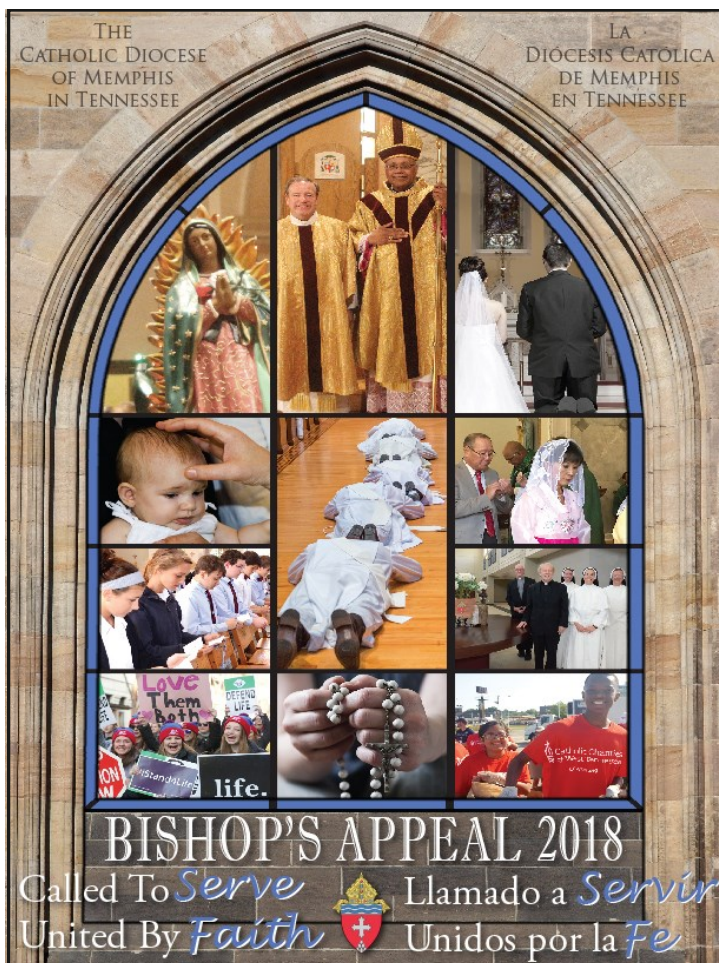

### FREE YOUTH FOOTBALL CAMP AT ST. BENEDICT

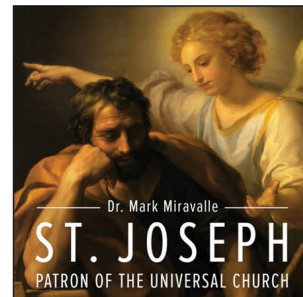
