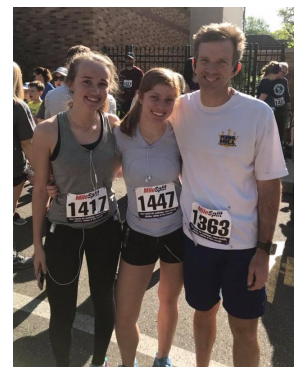
American Heritage Girls Raingutter Regatta
