

### WHY DID ST. LOUIS PARISH CHANGE THE SACRAMENTAL WINE?

The sacramental wine used at St. Louis Parish was recently changed from red wine to white wine. Sacramental wine can actually be red or white, dry or sweet. The reason we have changed from red wine to white wine is for practical reasons. It's very difficult to eliminate red wine stains from the purificators



when the volunteers who do Holy Wash are purifying them.

The wine used at Mass must be from the fruit of the vine (Luke 22:18), natural, and unadulterated (without other things added). There is no reference to the color of the wine, but only that it is made from grapes and not be soured.




