- Established in **1246** by **BISHOP ROBERT DE THORTE OF LIEGE** as suggested by **ST. JULIANA OF MONT CARVILLON**
- made **UNIVERSAL** by **POPE URBAN** in **1264**



It was **POPE JOHN PAUL II** who took the annual Corpus Christi procession from St. Peter's Square **TO THE STREETS OF ROME.**

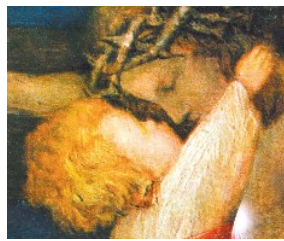
## ST. VINCENT DE PAUL HELP NEEDED!!!

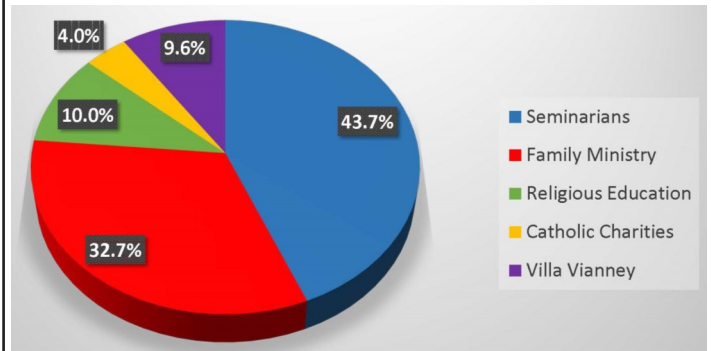

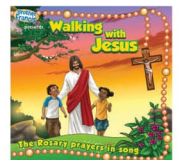
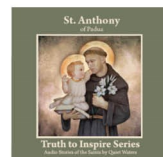


#### The Eucharist for Little Children
