

A Genuflection is made by bending the right knee to the ground and is a sign of adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament. Therefore, you should genuflect when you pass before Most Blessed Sacrament. During Mass, if the tabernacle with the Most Blessed Sacrament is in the church sanctuary, as opposed to a separate chapel, the Priest, Deacon, and other ministers genuflect when they approach the altar and when they depart. However, they do not genuflect during the celebration of the Mass itself if they pass before the tabernacle. [GIRM #274]
