## First Reconciliation Sacramental Preparation 2024

- To be eligible for First Reconciliation Sacramental Preparation your child must be enrolled in, and attending, weekly catechism classes at the parish.
- There are 6 parent and child preparation sessions for First Reconciliation.
- Three sessions will be facilitated at the parish
- Three sessions will be administered by parents/designated adult at home
- A parent, family member, or designated adult must attend the 3 in person sessions with your child.
- Completion of all 6 sessions, as well as the mini retreat attendance is required to be eligible to make their First Reconciliation on March 9<sup>th</sup>.
