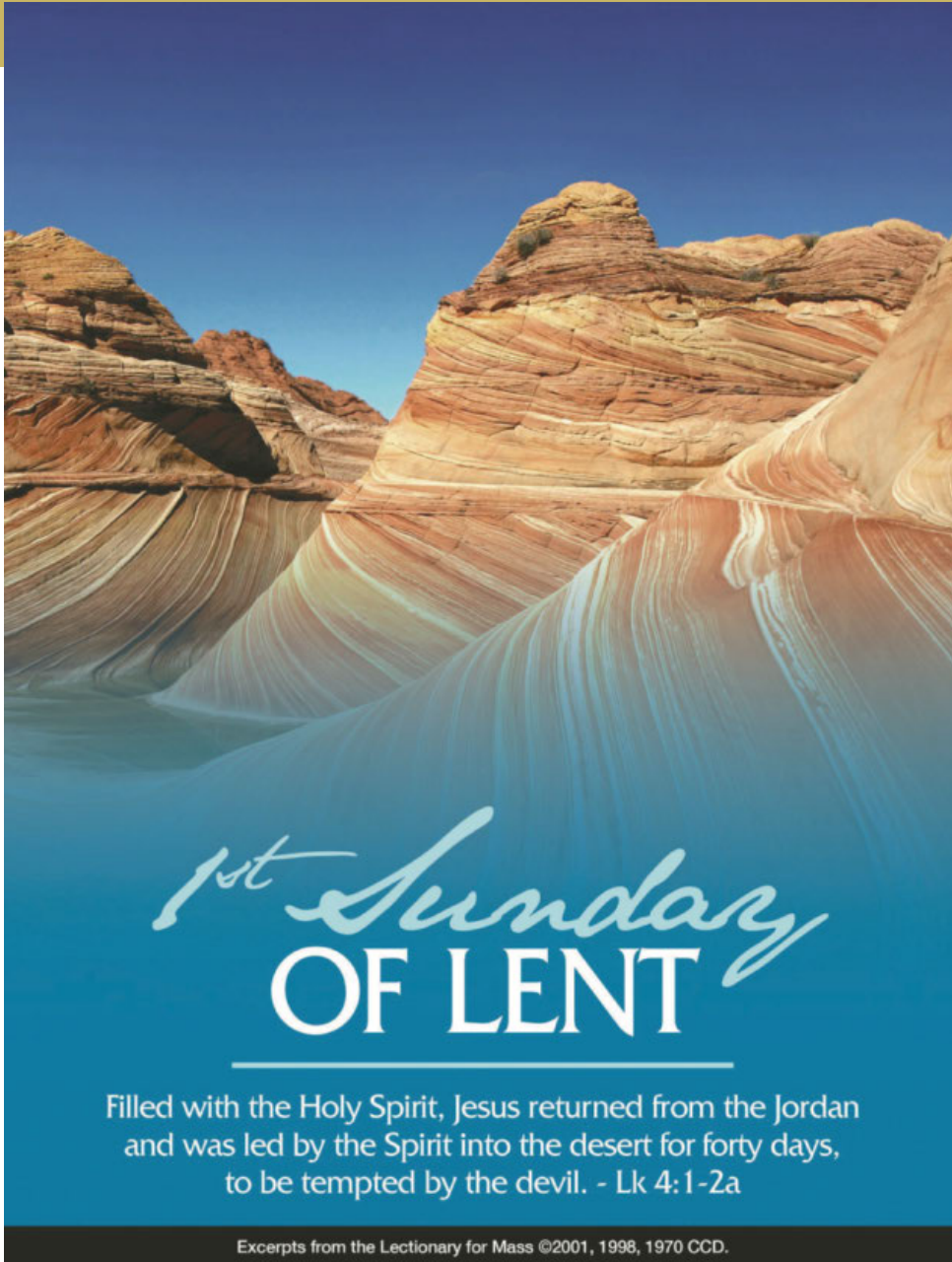

SACRAMENT INFORMATION

Baptisms

First Sunday of the month after the Noon Mass. Registration and Catechesis are prerequisites. Please contact the Parish Office.

Marriages

Contact the Parish Office upon engagement; at least six months is needed for preparation of this joyous sacrament!

Reconciliation & First Eucharist

Preparation for receiving the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Holy Eucharist for the first time usually begins in first grade. Children prepare either in a Catholic school or the parish Faith Formation program. The sacraments are administered through the Parish.

Confirmation

A two-year program for freshman & sophomore-age teens. Please apply through the Youth Ministry Program.

Communion for the Sick & Homebound

St. Rita Eucharistic Ministers provide Communion home visits. Contact the Parish Office.

Anointing of the Sick & Funeral Liturgies

Please notify us for the Anointing of the Sick, the sacrament intended for the seriously ill or dying which brings Our Lord's special presence and companionship in serious time of need. If someone should die without anointing, remember that the desire to receive is sufficient.

If your loved one has passed, we will assist in making arrangements with your chosen funeral director; refer you to our Bereavement Ministry and Music Ministry; and offer you helpful guidelines that will aid in the selection of readings for a Mass or Memorial Service. We know this can be a tough time and we want you to know that your parish is here for you. Please understand we only have one resident priest; sometimes arrangements for another priest may be needed.

FAST FROM COMPLAINING

Today we celebrate the 1st Sunday of Lent. The three pillars of Lent are prayer, fasting and almsgiving. These traditional Lenten disciplines are forms of self denial and they help us turn toward God as the source of our happiness. In prayer we admit our need for a power that is greater than ourselves – we recognize this power as God. By fasting we express our desire to find happiness in God rather than in the satisfaction of our physical needs. Through almsgiving we provide assistance to the needy and recognize God as the true source of our security.

In the gospel today we read the temptation of Jesus in the desert. This passage reminds us that God (Jesus Christ) understands our temptations

and will help us. But do I want God's help? Do I want to change my ways? Do I want to be holy? If these are true you can do it – but only with God's help. When Jesus was tempted and weak, he found his strength in God the Father. When we are weak and feel tempted to do wrong, we must turn toward God who loves us and will help us. Our parish theme about **fasting from complaining** can aid in this regard. The practices of prayer, fasting and almsgiving also help move us away from self-centeredness and open us to God's presence. This is my sincere prayer for each of you during this Lenten season – that you will be open to God's power and presence. Peace.

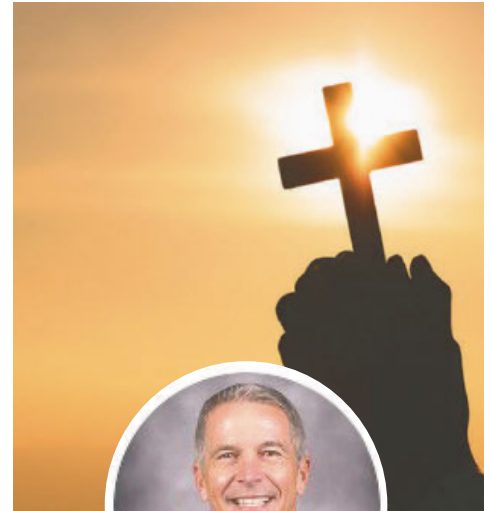

GUIDELINES FOR LENTEN DISCIPLINE

Catholics in good health ages 18 to 59 are required to fast and to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

Fasting consists of eating only one meal, with the possibility of two smaller snacks that do not add up to a single full meal.

Catholics ages 14 and older are to abstain from meat on all Fridays during Lent.

TAKING CHURCH OUTSIDE THE WALLS OF THE CHURCH

Jesus was tempted by the devil, and so are we.

What is your devil?

He tempts me all the time, but not with things like candy, over-indulgence, consumerism, jealousy, or focuses of physical, temporal things. My temptations are more spiritual and emotional in nature, as he steals my calm and attempts to replace it with stress, self-doubt, and peacelessness.

God doesn't want our hearts to be cluttered with resentment, anger, nonforgiveness, hate, (you can take it from there). Our hearts should be swept clean of those not-so-little things that the evil one tries to ruin our day with.
