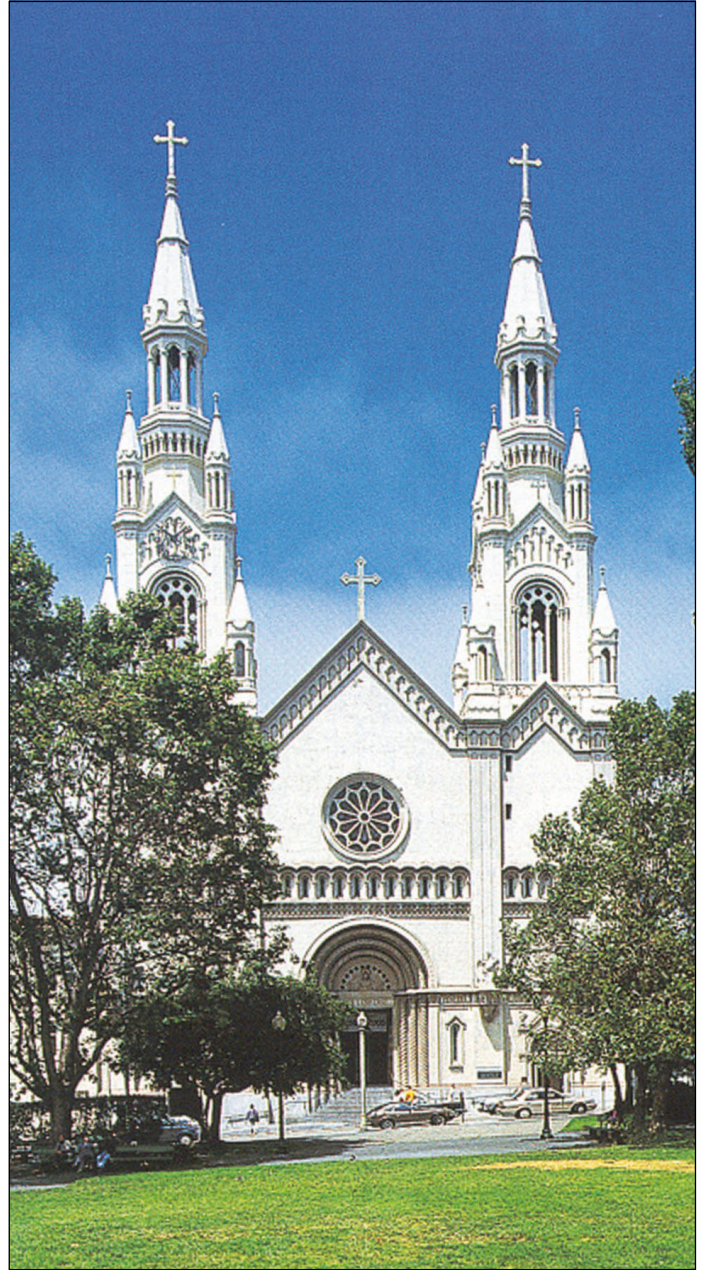

SAINT WHO?

St. David, King and Prophet

David's life, recorded in the books of Samuel, Kings, and Chronicles, abounded in drama—a life full of failures and humiliations as well as triumphs. Yet through it all, David's focus remained on the Lord, his Rock. His psalms (he wrote more than half of those in the Bible) reveal a passionate relationship with God.

In the historical accounts, David's music frequently appears in acts of compassion. As a boy, he was able to drive out King Saul's depression with his harping. Even though Saul became a bitter enemy, David mourned his death with a heartrending song of lament. Yet David's greatest musical achievement was in divine praises.

It was under David's leadership that the liturgical music of Israel blossomed. He stationed the Levites in the Lord's house with cymbals, Harps, and lyres (2 Chr 29:25). He commissioned four thousand musicians to serve in the Temple. The Book of Sirach sings in David's praise:

*With every deed he offered thanks
to God Most High, in words of praise.
With his whole heart he loved his Maker
and daily had His praises sung;
He added beauty to the feasts
and solemnized the seasons of each year
With string music before the altar,
providing sweet melody for the psalms
So that when the Holy Name was praised,
before daybreak the sanctuary would resound.
(Sir 47:8-10)*

Father, you found in David a man after your own heart, Whose confidence in you brought forth praise in abundance. May his psalms be ever on our lips and in our hearts!

復活期第四主日

耶穌喜歡把自己形容為牧羊人，而我們是祂的羊群。牧人看顧羊群，是耶穌當年以這樣的形像自喻，也許現在中東的許多地方的仍有這種景像。耶穌這樣地表示出泛愛所有人。世人屬於基督，如同羊群屬於牧人一樣。羊群賴於善牧才得生存，我們賴基督而得永生。基督就是我們救恩之源。耶穌以祂的福音教導我們，以祂的聖寵和聖事養育我們，願意所有人都得到永遠的生命，這恩典雖然人人有份，但也得看我們是否願意接受。耶穌的態度和我們的態度不同，祂不管我們接受不接受祂，更不管我們是怎樣的一個人，祂一律愛我們，接受我們。祂認識我們每一個人，知道我們內心的需要。

祂說：「我的羊聽我的聲音。」這表明凡願意成為基督羊群一份子的會和祂心靈相通。怎樣和耶穌心靈相通呢？就得先學習聽祂的聲音，最簡單的方法就是接受福音的教導，細意研究福音的真義，聽從教會、教宗、主教、神長的聲音；並留心細聽良心的聲音、內在的感召，因為這些都是耶穌的聲音，如果我們聽到了，又努力付諸實行，自然會和耶穌心靈相契了。

讓我們再讀讀今天的讀經一，聖保祿和巴爾納伯就是善於傾聽耶穌的聲音的最好例子。我們不妨問問自己，是不是留心聽耶穌的聲音？
