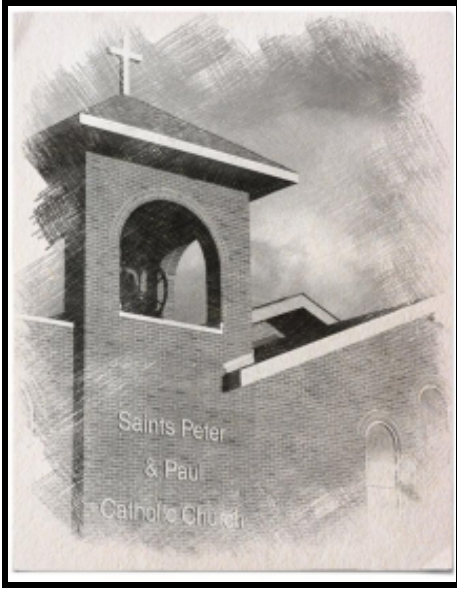

EUCCHARISTIC MIRACLES

Eucharistic Miracles – Surveys have indicated that up to 70% of Catholics do not believe in the True Presence of Jesus (Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity) in the Blessed Sacrament. To refute this misconception, here is another in a series of Eucharistic miracles.

The Miracle of Morrovalle, Italy– In 1597, an unidentified man belonging to a Moorish group approached Padre Juan Juarez of the Alcala de Henares Church with a piece of paper with 24 Hosts. The man admitted that his group had stolen sacred vessels from numerous churches and had also inflicted sacrileges to Hosts that had been contained in the sacred vessels.

These Hosts were placed in a small silver box because recently some priests had been poisoned and they were afraid that these Hosts might have been adulterated. For this reason, the box and its contents were not put in the church's tabernacle but were instead placed in the pantry.

Eleven years later, the Hosts were examined, and they retained their original color. It was then decided to place the Hosts in a subterranean vault along with some unconsecrated hosts in a similar box. In a few months, the unconsecrated hosts were spoiled, whereas the original Hosts still retained their color and freshness. After thorough scientific examination, there was no scientific explanation for their continued integrity. It was declared to be a miracle!
