SEASON OF LENT

This is a special time in the Church's year, like a forty-day retreat, when we are invited to closely examine ourselves, and to take some concrete steps to improve and become the person God calls us to be. Through the

years, the Church has pointed out the usefulness of the Lenten disciplines of prayer, fasting, and sharing our material goods as ways to achieve that goal. Let this coming Lent be a time of renewal.

LENTEN REGULATIONS There are two days when the law of fast and abstinence apply: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. The law of fast applies to those individuals of the ages 18 to 59, and it means that an individual may have one meal and may take nourishment (other than meat) twice during the day sufficient to maintain strength. Taken together, these two other opportunities for nourishment should not equal another meal. The Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence. The law of abstinence applies to those who are 14 years of age and older, and an individual is to abstain from meat on those days.

Your bad choices have landed you in jail, where rehabilitation resources are limited. Your mental illness may be undetected, or untreated. You could be estranged form your loved ones.

Unless you have been sentenced to life-in-prison, you will eventually return to a community and be "on your own" with minimal job skills, no driver's license, no place to sleep, no real friends to help you, and no money to buy food and other necessities of life! You Need Help! God asks all of us to help!

In 2016, we Vincentians from St. Mary's, Mansfield founded the Attleboro Vincentian Re-entry Program.

This all-volunteer, non-profit social-service and advocacy organization has helped over 2,000 formerly-incarcerated and recovering men, women and related families meet their practical and spiritual needs. Sometimes, we just lend a listening ear and an open and willing heart!

The Attleboro District Vincentian Reentry Program is experiencing a growing need for low-cost rental housing options, employers willing to give people second chances, and volunteers willing to be trained as mentors. If you have the time, talent, and willingness to serve on a really special team, come join us in this hugely-satisfying and challenging mission!


