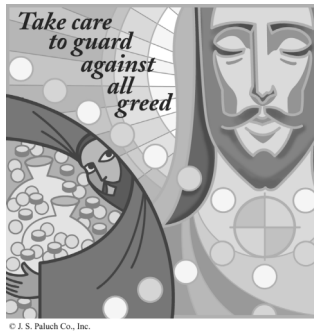

### First Saturday

During her July 1917 apparition at Fatima,  
Our Lady said to Lucy, "I shall come to ask...  
that on the First Saturday of every month,  
Communions of reparation be made in atonement  
for the sins of the world."

We are reinstating the practice of Mass on  
the First Saturday of the month. On August  
6, Mass will be offered at 8 a.m. at Sts. Peter  
& Paul in Frelsburg. The Mass will be  
offered at the high altar using the 1962  
Missale Romanum, also known as the  
Traditional Latin Mass. The Tridentine  
Mass was freed up by Pope Benedict XVI in  
his 2007 motu proprio entitled Summorum  
Pontificum. In it he said, "What earlier  
generations held as sacred, remains sacred  
and great for us too, and it cannot be all of a  
sudden entirely forbidden or even  
considered harmful." Mark your calendars  
for First Saturday, August 6, the Feast of  
the Transfiguration of our Lord, at 8 a.m. at  
Sts. Peter & Paul to honor our Lady's  
request for reparation.
