COMMUNION LINE ADDENDUM

One point I neglected to cover in the instruction about reserving the Communion line or procession for those intending to receive the Body of Christ in Holy Communion is that it is understandable that parents have their small children in tow. This is a great opportunity for parents to catechize their children on Holy Communion, on Whom it is that people are receiving when they receive the Sacred Host, and to develop in the children a holy desire for the moment when they will join their parents and older siblings in the actual reception of the Body of Christ. Everyone is blessed in the Final Blessing at the end of Mass, and the Church does not envision the bestowal of either a blessing or an acknowledgment to non-communicants at Communion time. With regard to small children, I invite and strongly encourage parents to use the approach of that moment as an opportunity to continue to prepare them for the time when they, too, will receive the Body of Christ.
