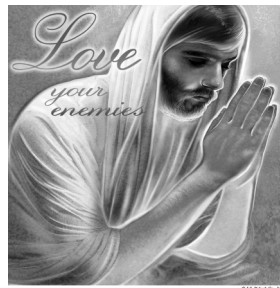

Ash Wednesday Fast & Abstinence

March 1 marks the beginning of Lent. The following fasting and abstinence regulations are observed.

Abstinence from meat is observed on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all the Fridays of Lent by all Catholics 14 years and older.

Fasting is observed on Ash Wednesday & Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59. One full meatless meal is taken and two much smaller meatless meals are permitted if absolutely necessary to maintain strength according to one’s needs. Eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

Most important is your attitude! Fasting & abstinence only benefit those who practice them with the intention of drawing closer to God & achieving self discipline. Internal desire and external practice work together to make us holy.

update...**

In the spring of 2015, a diocesan insurance adjuster visited our church to do our annual inspection and it was noted that we needed to fix the falling ceiling tiles in the church. The financial council has been working on obtaining bids, and a date has been set to get started. In order for this to happen, we will have to relocate church over to the parish hall for 6-8 weeks. Work will begin on March 6. The Building Board of the Diocese of Victoria approved the parish proposal. If you have any questions, please contact the parish office.
