## Weekly Reflection ~January 20 2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

Paul reminds the Corinthians that while there are many gifts there is the same Spirit. Each of us has been given a gift—a manifestation of the Spirit—that has been entrusted to us to use for the common good. What gift have you been given? Your gifts may not be ones that are readily acknowledged by society, like being a great actor or teacher or athlete. They may be more "hidden" or unnamed. There is the gift of hospitality—making people feel at ease. The confidant who people can share their hopes and fears with. It may be a knack for cooking or sewing or working with children. Think about the things you are good at—things other people think you do well. These are your gifts. How are you using your gifts for the benefit of others?
