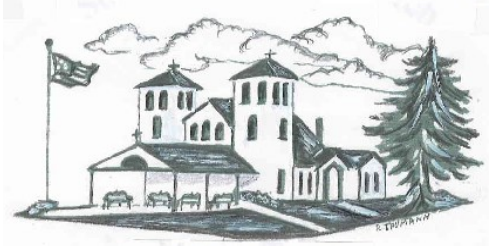
MARRIAGE:

October 13 Mass for Our Lady of Fatima

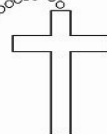
