




Advent wreaths and candles are available on the table in the back of church along with Advent Companions & St. Joseph Missals.



Weekly Reflection ~ November 29 First Sunday in Advent

Once again we begin a new Church year with season of Advent. It is a time of anticipation and waiting as we prepare for the celebration of the birth of Jesus – Love made flesh.
