

## *Weekly Reflection ~ February 6* *Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time*

*In the privacy of our own hearts, we are very aware of our own faults and shortcomings. It is easy to wonder how we could ever be "worthy" of becoming God's instrument for good in the world. However both Isaiah and Paul remind us that in spite of our sinfulness, God's grace is there for us. His grace heals and strengthens us. It prepares us to be a power for good. All that is required is that we accept God's grace and be willing to do God's will. How open are you to the grace of God? How willing are you to do God's will instead of your own?*
