

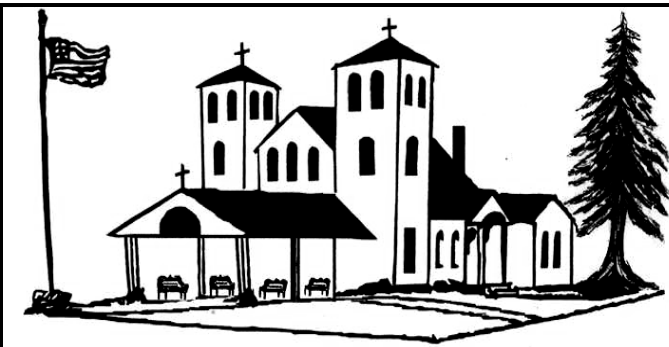

Weekly Reflection ~ September 18 Twenty-Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time
