## Confirmation Program Changes

Beginning this fall, St. Anthony, St. Roch, and St. Peter and St. Paul Parishes will begin offering a joint parish program for the Sacrament of Confirmation. This Confirmation program will begin in the student's 8<sup>th</sup> grade year and conclude at the beginning of the fall semester of the 9<sup>th</sup> grade year with the reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation. This program will take the place of 8th grade CCE. Students AND parents are required to attend the first class on Wednesday, September 6, at 6:30pm in the SAS Library. A lot of information will be given, so please make plans to attend.

SAS 8<sup>th</sup> graders will begin Confirmation preparation in their religious education classes. They will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation at the beginning of the fall semester of the 9<sup>th</sup> grade year also.

There will no longer be a High School Confirmation Program after this school year. Therefore, ALL HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS (incoming 9<sup>th</sup> graders-12<sup>th</sup> graders) who have not yet received the Sacrament of Confirmation and would like to, need to attend the High School Confirmation program this year. This program will begin Sunday, September 10th at 9am in the St. Anthony Cafeteria and conclude at the beginning of the fall semester of the next year with the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Please complete the forms and bring them and copies of the student's Baptism and First Communion Certificates to the St. Anthony Church office prior to the first class.
