Living the Gospel with Joy

It is an odd thing to expect when you are sent out on a difficult mission without power, possessions, comforts, or necessities. But yet, with simplicity and trust in God, the seventy-two disciples that were sent in that way returned rejoicing, amazed at the power of Jesus' name. Yet Jesus reminds them: *“Do not rejoice because the spirits are subject to you, but rejoice because your names are written in heaven.”* (Luke 10:20)

This is the heart of Christian joy: not in success or recognition, but in belonging to Christ.

Gospel joy is not just a feeling. It's a fruit of living the mission of bringing Christ's peace to others. That can seem like a daunting task, no less true for the seventy-two. Yet by remaining faithful, they experienced that joy.
