“Let's Sing with the Pope”

In his first public appearance since his election as the Vicar of Christ, Pope Leo XIV lead the faithful of over 100,000 gathered at St. Peter's Square in the Regina Coeli. Pope Leo XIV did not simply recite the prayer to our Blessed Mother, he chanted it.

Pope Leo XIV takes to heart the beauty of the Church's prayer. He is called up to do the same. The Vatican has launched an initiative called "Singing with the Pope"—a digital platform and YouTube channel consisting of short educational video tutorials. The goal of this effort is to help the faithful actively participate in liturgical celebrations with the Holy Father. You will learn how to read and sing simple notes, while also receive the explanation of the Latin texts.

Through this channel, Pope Leo XIV invites the whole Church to learn, sing, and pray together using the timeless chants and sacred melodies that have formed the backbone of Catholic worship for centuries.

To find the channel simply search “Singing with the Pope” on YouTube or scan the QR code.

This is more than just a resource—it's a way to stay connected to the universal Church, to our Holy Father, and to the unity of worship that binds us together as one people of faith.

Here in our parish, we too continue to the use of chant as prescribed by the Sacred Liturgy. Sacred Music is not about nostalgia or performance—it's about deepening our reverence, participating more fully in the liturgy, and letting the beauty of the Church's worship transform our hearts.

Let us not be afraid to raise our voices in prayerful song. May our worship always be a true offering of praise, united with the Church around the world, and with the successor of Peter who leads us in faith and song.
