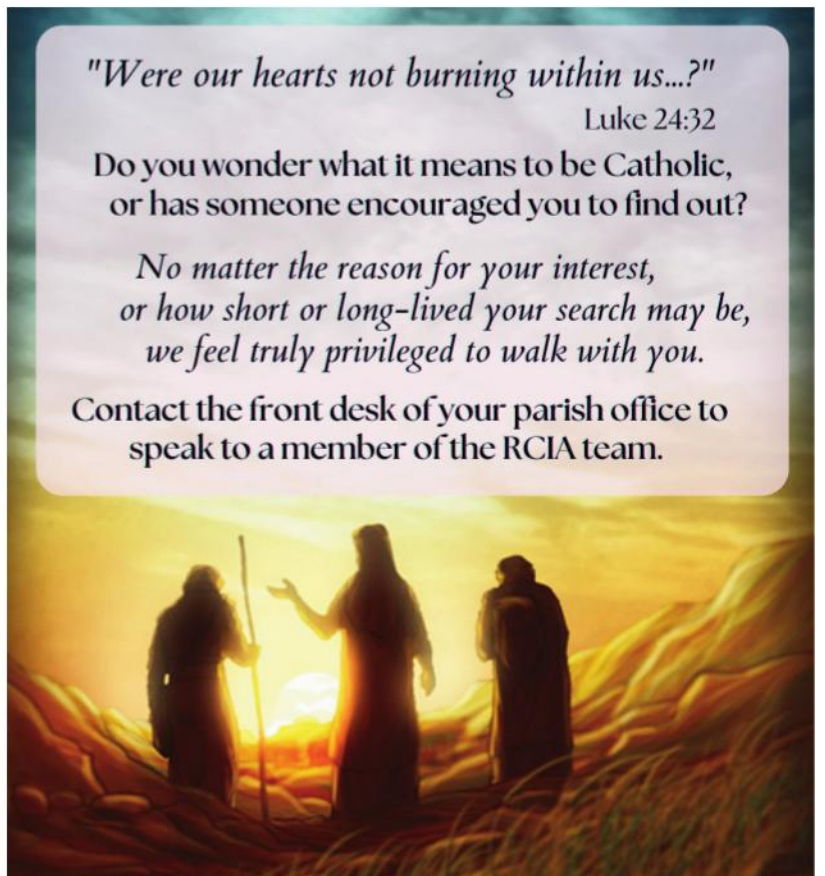

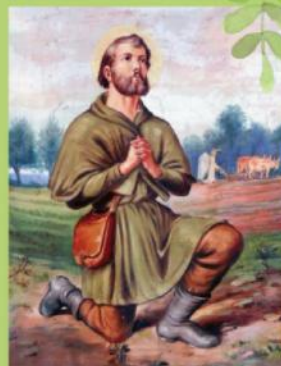
SCRIPTURE STUDY

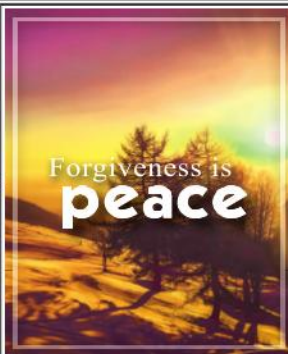
