

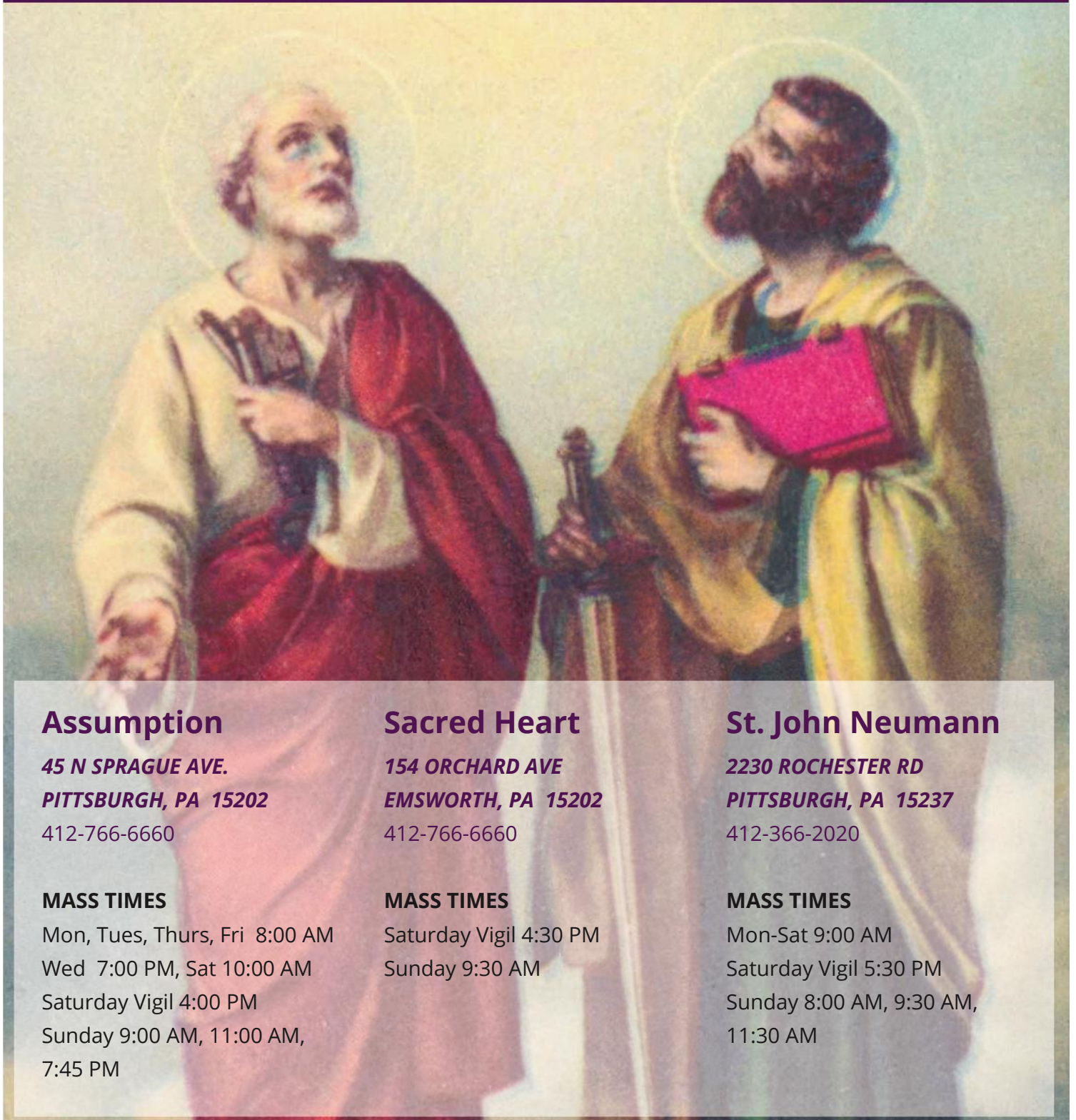

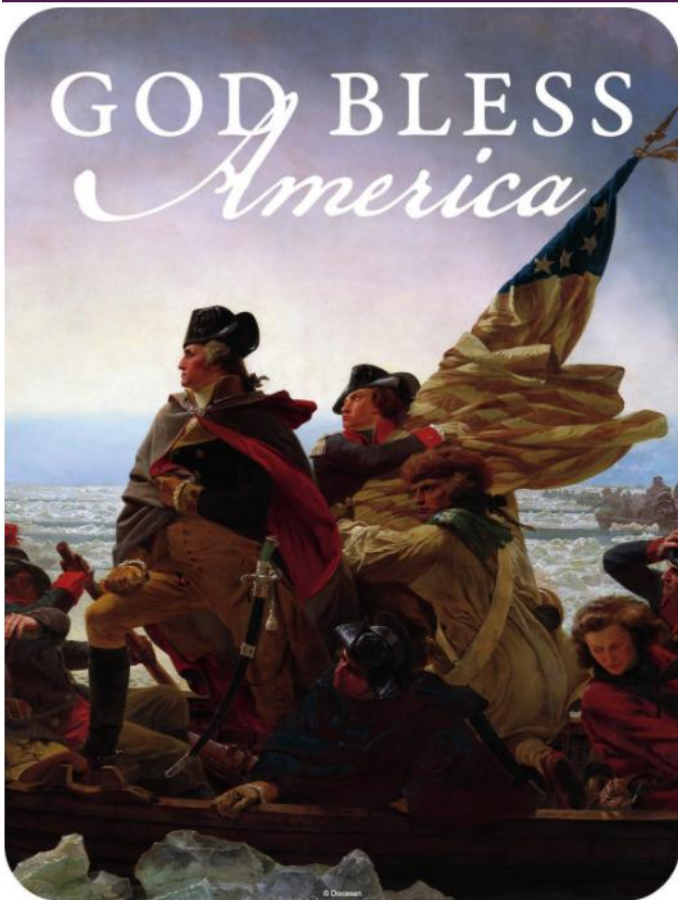

July 4th Mass Schedule—Please note the change in the Mass schedule for Friday, July 4th. Mass at Assumption will be at **10 AM** only. There will be no 8 am Mass or 7 pm First Friday Mass. Saint John Neumann will have 9 am Mass as regularly scheduled. All-night Adoration from July 4-5 is also canceled.

First Saturday—There will not be all-night Adoration going into July 5th for the First Saturday this month. Assumption Church will still have 9 am confessions, 9:30 am Rosary, and 10 am Mass for First Saturday devotions. Saint John Neumann will also have Mass at 9am on Saturday.

Blessing of Expectant Parents

As an extension of the St. Gerard Ministry, the Regina Coeli Parish offers Blessing of Expectant Parents on the first Sunday of every month.

Blessings take place after the 9:00 am Mass at Assumption and after 9:30 am Mass at St. John Neumann.

FAITH FORMATION 2025

As a parish, Regina Coeli offers several catechetical models to best meet the needs of every family. However, it is important to understand that the programs we offer are not identical in approach. While CCD, Family Catechesis, and Catechesis of the Good Shepherd are all effective ways to form your children in the faith, they each employ different methods of catechesis. Since each year's content builds upon the last it is not best practice to switch your child from one program to another without a serious reason. We advise families to commit to the model that best meets the needs of their children. Accommodations can be made on an as needed basis but frequent transitions between programs are not ideal.

CCD - CCD is traditional, classroom-based religious education for children in **Kindergarten - Grade 8**. All classes meet Tuesday evenings at 6:15pm at Assumption. We will be using Sophia Press's *Spirit of Truth* books for grades K-7 and *Chosen: Your Journey to Confirmation* for 8th grade.

Family Catechesis - Family Catechesis engages the whole family in learning about the Catholic faith. Families with children in **grades K - 6** join us for Mass at St. John Neumann followed by separate teaching sessions for parents and children one Sunday per month. Lessons for the rest of the month are completed as a family at home. This year we will be using Sophia Press's *A Family of Faith Vol 4: Christian Prayer*.

Ignite - Ignite is a faith formation program for **grades 6-8** that uses relational learning to help students encounter the living God through the riches of the Catholic faith. The faith is transmitted through catechesis, scripture study, small groups, and prayer experiences. Ignite meets Wednesday evenings in Bovard Hall at St. John Neumann from 6:30-8:00.

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd - Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is a Montessori based model of faith formation for children beginning at 3 years old through grade 6. CGS meets once a week on a variety of days of your choosing in a prepared space called the Atrium. Children receive weekly presentations on Scripture and Liturgy that help to foster their own personal relationship with Jesus, the Good Shepherd.

CATECHESIS OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD TODDLER ATRIUM



Regina Coeli is one of the only Parishes in the diocese to have all three Levels of Catechesis of the Good Shepherd Atria. This past year, Regina Coeli has worked diligently to create



a fourth, new environment for toddlers. Like the atrium for other age groups, the toddler environment is designed to be a developmentally appropriate room where very young children can live their relationship with God.

Parents are the first and most important catechists of their children and home is where the child first hears the Gospel message through the love and care of parents and family. Toddler atria support parents in their role as catechists and takes special care to provide what the young child needs physically, emotionally, intellectually, and spiritually. Children from birth to age 3 have three particular "sensitivities" that guide and influence

their development and learning: order, movement, and language. Young children thrive on routine and 'sameness.'

This sensitivity to order helps the child to discover and make sense of the world. It is important that children feel comfortable in their environment and that they experience little change without prior preparation.

The toddler atrium is simple and beautiful to allow the child to know what to expect and where to find what he or she wants. A toddler environment also allows for continuous movement and development of large and small motor skills. Children are free to move about the room and choose activities with which to work. Materials and activities on the shelf are designed to aid the child in development of motor skills. Tables, stools, and shelves are low to the ground, allowing the child to become independent and self-reliant. Children learn language by absorption. As the child listens to people, the sounds and words are stored in a special part of the brain. Language just seems to emerge from the child, beginning with simple sounds, then words, and finally full sentences

and thoughts. The toddler atrium speaks to this sensitivity to language by surrounding the child with the rich language of the church. The names of sacred vessels are presented. Songs are sung, and as we know, music helps the body and mind work together. Music also allows the child to express joy. The

Word of God is read and spoken in prayer. The language of gestures (movements) are also presented to the young child, such as the Sign of the Cross. In the toddler atrium, children learn through purposeful movement and discovery. This helps to provide a foundation for the succeeding atrium environments, as well as nurturing the child's relationship with Jesus, the Good Shepherd.



In this year dedicated to hope...it is our hope to offer 2 times weekly for toddlers to come experience God's love in the atrium beginning this fall!

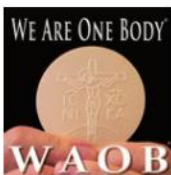
