



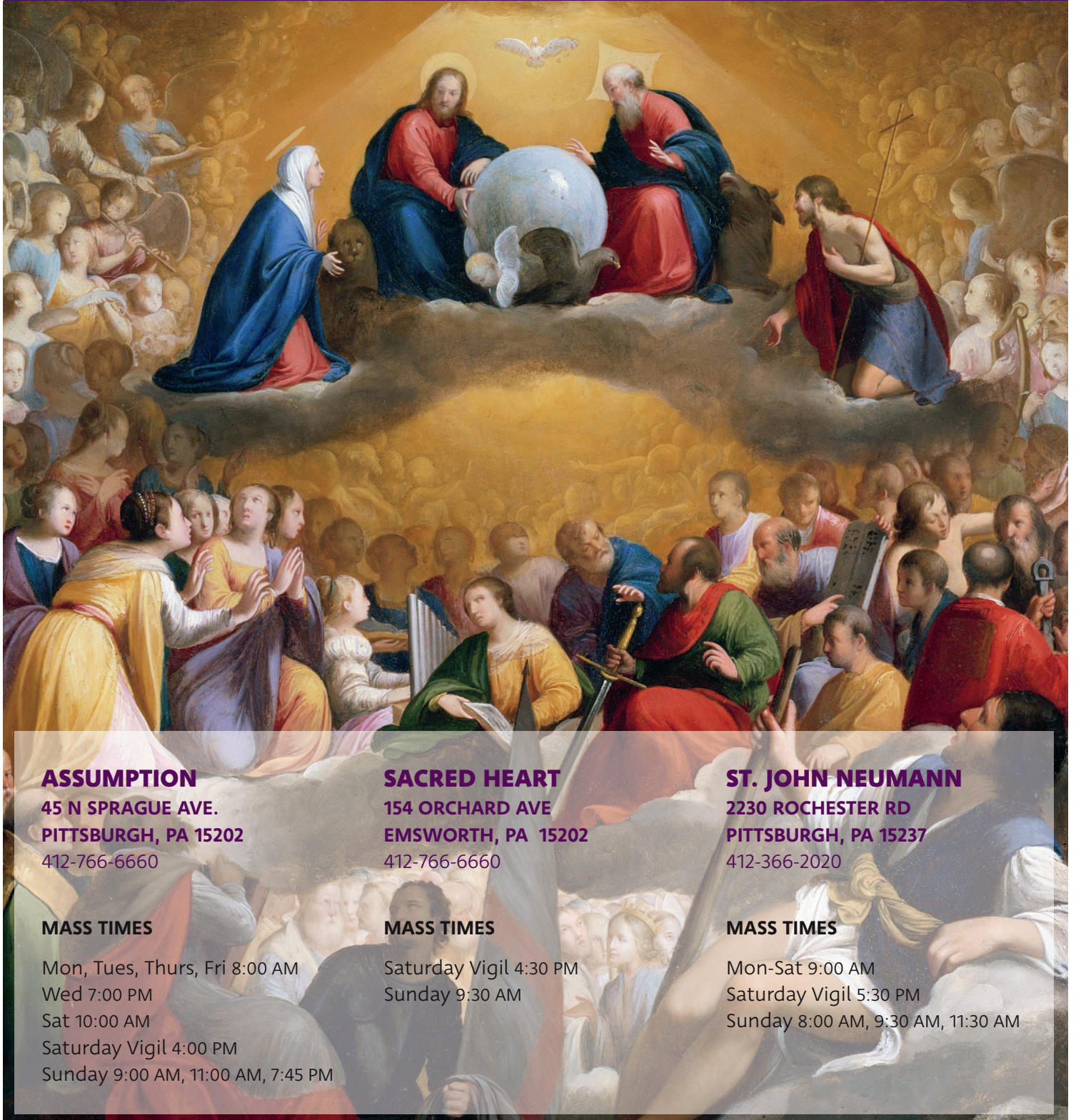

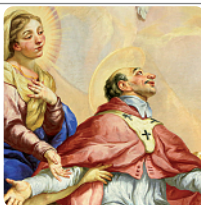


Blessing of Expectant Parents

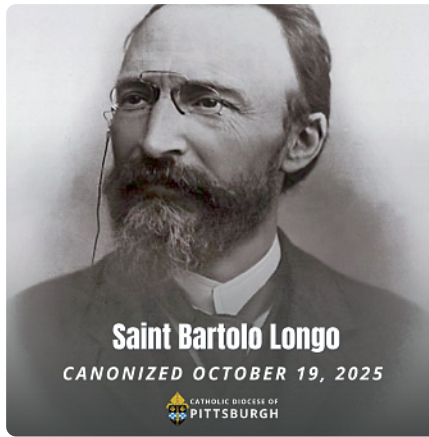
This Week in our CGS Atria...

A Brief Biography of Recently Canonized Saint Bartolo Longo

—Bartolo Longo is one of seven new saints canonized by Pope Leo XIV on October 19, 2025. He was born in 1841 in southern Italy to a devoutly Catholic

family, but his father died when he was just 10 years old. As a young adult, he developed a hatred and a negative attitude for the Church, the clergy, and the Holy Father. Bartolo embraced occult practices and even Satanism, and he was consecrated a Satanic priest. A very devout professor became very worried about Bartolo and invited him to move into his home. With encouragement from this professor, along with a Dominican priest and a nun, Bartolo eventually went to confession and began to heal, but the process was slow. One day, when Bartolo was feeling particularly hopeless, he remembered one of the promises of Our Lady to St. Dominic: "He who propagates my Rosary will find salvation." Falling to his knees, Bartolo exclaimed to the Mother of God, "If your words are true that he who propagates your Rosary will be saved, I shall reach salvation, because I shall not leave this earth without propagating your Rosary." From that day forward, Bartolo untiringly promoted the Rosary as he took care of the poor, orphans, and those who did not know the truth of the Catholic Faith. He was instrumental in the building of the Basilica of Our Lady of the Rosary in Pompei, as well as schools and orphanages for poor children. Up to his death in 1926, Bartolo promoted the Rosary and witnessed to the truth of Jesus Christ. In 1980, he was beatified by Pope St. John Paul II, who called him the "Apostle of the Rosary." St. Bartolo Longo's life reminds us that no matter how dark a person's past may be, God's mercy and grace offer us salvation.

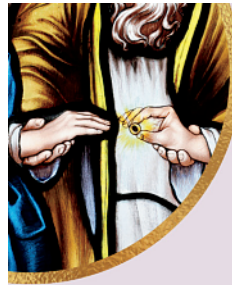

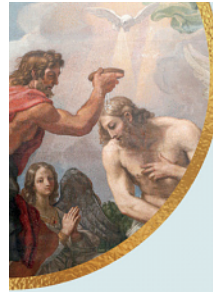
