



Online Stewardship/Donations to St. Peter's Parish

All of our parish mission, administration, facilities, and operations are funded through the generous donations of our parishioners. We do not get any funding from the Archdiocese, Chancery or even Rome! Since Online Giving has been made available through new technologies and our banking partners, St. Peter's Parish has seen a slow but steady increase of families who choose to donate on a regular basis in this way.

Online Giving is easier and less work over time on the part of each individual family and household, and our parish staff and volunteers. Presently, online donations range anywhere from 28% to 57% of the weekly collections. We would encourage even more families to consider giving in this same way.

As you know, we recently announced that we changed our online giving platform. We are now using the ParishSOFT Giving portal. It is quick and easy. 

Old Rectory

This photograph depicts the old rectory and the three stages of the demolition and clearing of it. The rectory served many purposes in its years of existence, including the offices and residence of Fr. Tony Cummins, the Life Teen House, and most recently, the residence for Fr. Norm in his first couple of years assigned here. The demolition was completed this past week clearing the site to become approximately 30 to 40 additional parking spaces. We intend to make more handicap parking in this area, and our Safety & Security golf cart patrol will be able to give rides to parishioners to the church doors. Remember, this demolition and installation of additional parking spaces is part of the Parish Master Plan developed during the building of the Family Life Center. Additionally, as part of that plan, the Knights of Columbus are in the process of building a new storage and meeting facility at our new property, the Upon this Rock Campus. Once it is completed, the old KC storage building and Bar-B-Que/Gathering Pavilion

behind the Church will also be demolished, cleared and turned into parking spaces. This is all required in order to meet City Code standards to finish it and get a Certificate of Occupancy for the third floor of the Family Life Center that is yet incomplete.

With our purchase of the Upon the Rock Campus from the Benedictine Sisters, and now with the possibility of building a Catholic School, we can re-envision how the third floor might be used in our current parish stage of development. That opens a lot of very interesting possibilities to further expand our services, ministries and overall parish mission. For example, we need much more office space for staff, deacons, spiritual direction rooms, etc. We also need to build a Parish Archives Room, more mid-size event space, etc.

In mid-September, we make our final payment on the Bond taken out with Frost Bank to build the Family Life Center. That will make our parish debt-free at a critical stage in our parish history and point of potential development and growth.
