An ofrenda nicho is a small box that displays a picture of your loved one, with small momentos that had significance to your loved one. These nichos can be placed on the Altar of the Dead. See the picture on the right of the nicho with candle in it.

This year, in 2022, we encourage families to make a nicho for their picture, that will be displayed on St. Peter's Altar of the Dead. Cigar boxes and small shoe boxes make great nichos. You can spray or hand paint them, use Catholic images, decorate with flowers, crepe paper, ribbons, sequins, glitter, etc., and include the picture of your loved one.

Then bring your nicho to the Narthex and set it in the basket or on the table. When we set up the altar, we will find a place for your nicho. Please make sure to have your name and phone number on the bottom of your nicho.

Una ofrenda nicho es una pequeña caja que muestra una foto de su ser querido, con pequeños momentos que tuvieron un significado para su ser querido. Estos nichos se pueden colocar en el Altar de Muertos. Vea la foto a la derecha del nicho con una vela.

Este año, en 2022, animamos a las familias a hacer un nicho para su foto, que pondremos en el Altar de Muertos de San Pedro. Las cajas de puros y las cajas pequeñas de zapatos son excelentes nichos. Puedes pintarlos con aerosol o a mano, usar imágenes católicas, decorar con flores, papel crepé, listones, lentejuelas, brillantina, etc., e incluir la foto de tu ser querido.

Luego lleva tu nicho al Narthex y ponlo en la canasta o sobre la mesa. Cuando instalemos el altar, encontraremos un lugar para tu nicho. Asegúrete de tener tu nombre y número de teléfono en la parte inferior de tu nicho.

Altar of the Dead 2022

From October 20 to November 4, we will have our Altar of the Dead in the Narthex. We invite all who wish to participate to leave photos of their deceased loved ones in the provided baskets with their name, your name, and phone number on the back of the photos.

What is Día de los Muertos?

Día de los Muertos celebrates those who have passed with festivities of joy and laughter. Brightly colored ofrendas (altars) are erected at gravesites, in homes and churches with pictures of deceased loved ones. The ofrendas commonly feature Cempasuchil, bright orange and yellow marigolds intended to cheer up the dead with their brilliant colors and sweet scent, favorite items, food and drink, and pan de muerto, a slightly sweet bread made specifically for this occasion.

Skeletons and skulls, dressed as ordinary people, even a bride and groom, mock or make fun of death, since we have the promise of new life in Christ and death is not the end for us.

It is a celebration of life - our lives and the lives of those who have passed before us.

If you have cigar boxes you no longer want, please consider donating them for our Altar. They can be dropped off in the Parish Office.

Altar de los Muertos 2022

Del 20 de octubre al 4 de noviembre tendremos nuestro Altar de los Muertos en el Nártex. Invitamos a todos los que deseen participar a dejar fotos de sus seres queridos fallecidos en las canastas provistas con su nombre y número de teléfono en el reverso de las fotos.

¿Qué es el Día de los Muertos?

El Día de los Muertos celebra a los fallecidos con festejos de alegría. Se erigen ofrendas (altares) de colores brillantes en las tumbas, hogares e iglesias con fotografías de seres queridos fallecidos. Las ofrendas incluyen Cempasuchil, caléndulas de color naranja brillante y amarillo destinadas a alegrar a los muertos con sus colores brillantes y aroma dulce, sus platos favoritos, comida y bebida, y pan de muerto, un pan ligeramente dulce hecho específicamente para esta ocasión.

Esqueletos y calaveras, vestidos como gente común, incluso novios, se burlan de la muerte, ya que tenemos la promesa de una nueva vida en Cristo y la muerte no es el final para nosotros.

Es una celebración de la vida: nuestras vidas y las vidas de aquellos que han pasado antes que nosotros.

Si tiene cajas de puros que ya no quiere, considere donarlas para nuestro Altar. Se pueden dejar en la Oficina Parroquial.

TOP SYNOD FEEDBACK

The first phase of the synodal process has been completed at St Peter's with great success. We received great feedback from the various ministries as well as our general listening sessions. We conducted 17 separate encounter sessions and received 75 reflection sheets with over 450 comments on what St Peter's is doing well and how the Holy Spirit is guiding us in the future. This document is a summary of the top seven themes with summary comments/suggestions. The full Synodal Feedback for St. Peter's and the Archdiocese is posted to our parish website at stpetersboerne.com. This information has also been presented to the Pastoral Council, Stewardship Council, and the Parish staff.

Ministries

Our ministries, while being active and vibrant, need to develop creative ways to invite more people to be a part of their "journeying together." Invite members back to ministries who might have dropped off due to the pandemic. Make sure outreach occurs to new parishioners and those who sign up for a ministry. Increase ministries supporting one another and working together.

Welcoming

We need to continue offering more personal interaction activities for parishioners after Mass. Parishioners should make more attempts to introduce ourselves to those we don't know to make them feel welcome. Stepping out of our comfort zones and engaging with others of different backgrounds and ideas. Including acknowledgement of other ministries within our parish community.

Communication/Live Streaming Services

We need to leverage our Parish website and our Facebook page and Instagram to highlight our various ministries and how they serve the Church and community. We need to develop a process and procedures to allow more access to our website, Instagram and Facebook so we can share what is happening (i.e., what we are doing and what is planned).

Continue our efforts/progress in improving use of technology to fulfill our mission for Christ. The upcoming improvement to our sound system is a great example. We should also develop a plan to bring cameras to classrooms so we can offer online classes.

Family Life & Faith Formation (Children and Teens)

St Peter's Family Life programs & Youth Faith Formation are keys in catechizing and helping families and our youth in practicing their faith in this current culture. The new Children's Mass every month is a great opportunity and blessing to focus on the young children and their families. We need to also work on involvement in and attendance at the Life Teen Mass. We have also started many successful family events which should be continued. Every opportunity should be made to emphasize Adoration and the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist.

St Peter's needs to also increase parish staff support for Family Life programs and Youth Faith Formation. We are blessed to have several parents involved in youth formation, but we need to improve parental involvement at every level. We are leaning too much on the same cadre of parents in some of these areas and burnout is an issue. This should be a focus area of how we recruit and retain parents and families in these programs.

Lay Spiritual Formation and Vocations

St Peter's is a vibrant parish and has many programs to offer but we need to highlight religious vocations more. Examples: have pastor give a homily on what life is like as a priest. Have a seminarian talk at one of the Masses or have a trip for the teens to the seminary and have them talk to the seminarians. The Deacons could give a homily on their journey to the deaconate.

Have more discussions and or presentations to discuss how our faith should be used in daily life and how our Christianity applies to world and social justice issues such as Catholic Charities, tithing, annulment, divorce, immigration, homelessness, foster care, homosexuality, and Catholic Church teachings.

Multicultural Inclusion (Demographics as well as different cultures)

St Peter's continues to improve on reaching out and engaging to our Hispanic parishioners through our bulletin and website. How can we identify and leverage our bilingual parishioners to help at cross cultural events/ministries to aid communication and relationships.

Work with the Pastoral Council and Ministries to develop processes to reach out to and engage with those that feel marginalized (i.e., young teens, elderly, the ill, and physically impaired). For example, a simple call or visit would be a great benefit to those in need.

Community Outreach and Ecumenism

St Peter's Parish has expanded our outreach to the local community through several events (i.e., St Peter's July 4th celebration, Fall Festival and Veterans Day) as well as through various ministries. We need to continue to reach out and inform the parish and our community of these ministries to evangelize and spread the gospel.

NEW TEXAS HISTORICAL COMMISSION MARKER AT ST. PETER'S



St. Peter's will host a presentation and unveiling of a new Texas Historical Marker, in conjunction with Kendall County on November 4th at 10:00 am at the Upon

this Rock Campus, St Anthony Hall. The marker is for the Camino Real de San Saba (Comino Viejo), which is one of two authenticated trails in Kendall County. This new THC marker is a documented pathway that dates back to the Spanish colonial era and documents a pathway with roots to an early San Saba mission and presidio.

ALL SOULS DAY HISTORY

Purgatory is a necessary state of suffering for those who've died in a state of grace. It provides for the cleansing and purification needed for entering heaven and the presence of God. Prayers for those souls go back to the Old Testament (2 Maccabees 12:41-46) and is referenced in the New Testament (2 Tim 1:18, Matt 12:32).

St. Odilo of Cluny, a Benedictine Abbot in the 10th century, began the practice of prayers, intercessions, alms giving and visits to the cemetery for the deceased monks. This practice spread among the monasteries and in 1030 AD, St. Odilo established the Feast of All Souls Day, now observed on November 2nd.

In 1065 AD, Pope Urban II, remitted all penances for those who participated in the Crusades. Those who were not able to participate could offer their confession and financial support for the Crusades, this was the beginning of indulgences.

Indulgences may be partial or full (plenary) remission of a soul's sins. There are many ways to offer indulgences, such as prayers, Masses, visiting cemeteries and alms giving. These carry with them a

plenary or partial indulgence. We can continue to offer love and mercy to deceased loved ones or departed souls with no one to pray for them.

Prayers for indulgences may be found in many books such as The Manual of Indulgences by the USCCB.


