

### Pastor's Desk

This year, we have so much to be thankful for. While we had already been gradually returning to some inperson activities, such as Masses, this year, we returned to so many more, the most prominent of which are the Fall Festival and ACTS Retreats. That we sold out of the spaghetti dinner three days early, and that all of the Women's ACTS Retreat spots were filled, serves as testament to the fact that people are ready to gather inperson again, and we have been able to do so.

We are also returning to a full slate of activities and celebrations for the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe on December 12, which includes Las Mañanitas, followed by a morning gathering, the Our Lady of Guadalupe Mass in the evening, followed by the popular dinner in the Cana Ballroom. This year, the entertainment includes Los Matachines, Mariachis and Ballet Folklórico. Don't miss it!

This year has also brought us so many new and wonderful activities for the youngest members of our parish such as the monthly children's Masses, monthly story time in the Elizabeth Anne Dashiell Library located in the Family Life Center, Friday Family Adoration, and Cookie Friday at the playground. In addition, this past summer we had a very successful Fun Fest.

We are thankful for making our final payment in September on the bond for building our Family Life Center. That means we are debt-free in the parish. We have now moved on to significant projects in the parish: tearing down the old rectory and preparing to add parking spaces, including handicapped parking spaces, in the upper parking lot; replacement of the gym roof,

including installing additional insulation and new skylights; continuing renovations at our Upon this Rock campus, preparing new meeting space for Catechesis of the Good Shepherd and other organizations; asphalting a larger area for parking at the new property, just to name a few. All of these projects are due to your generosity, for which we are so thankful.

Behind the scenes, incredible progress is being made on consideration of building a Catholic School at St. Peter's. Some significant announcements will be made in the near future regarding the progress on the Feasibility Study. We are thankful to Tina and Clarence Kahlig for their incredible generosity in donating the seed money for this project. Please stay tuned for more information. Thank God for this opportunity to expand the mission of this parish.

We are also especially thankful for the new ministries started in our parish including Precious Gifts Ministry (for families experiencing a miscarriage), That Man is You, and the Hill Country Daily Bread Welcome to the Table Family Mentoring Program.

Finally, and long-awaited, we are thankful to once again partake of the Precious Blood of Christ in Holy Communion, beginning November 27th. Hallelujah!

This Thanksgiving, take time to give thanks for all of God's blessings upon you, your family and our parish. Enjoy and celebrate in your fellowship with one another. I hope you enjoy your special time with family and friends. Happy Thanksgiving to you all!

As a parish, let generosity and thanksgiving continue to be our hallmark!

### **Gospel Meditation**

It's not unreasonable to think that if God wanted to make a statement he could do so in a very dramatic way. After all, he spoke through a burning bush that didn't actually burn, parted the Red Sea, sent manna to the Israelites from the sky, cured lepers, healed the sick and cast out demons. All of that is pretty dramatic stuff, and they made statements! Now, Jesus hangs dying on a cross. He has been referred to as a king. Considering all of the miracles Jesus did in his short time on earth, isn't one more in order? If Jesus came down off of the cross. defied death, and parted the waters of suffering and death, onlookers, believers and unbelievers alike, would take notice. It would prove who God is and show us what God wants us to do. Or would it?

Great spiritual masters remind us not to focus on miracles or consolations received from God. They can distract us. Doing anything other than what Jesus did would distract humanity as well, misplacing our focus. It's not about a miracle, at least not the dramatic kind people are eager to see. It's about something more profound. It all goes back to where it began for the earthly Jesus. God becomes one with humanity in Jesus Christ. All that goes into being human is holy and blessed, and that becomes a place where God is born, again and again. God, through Jesus, tells us to hold firm to all of the experiences of being human, the joys

and the wonders, the disappointments and the failures.

God's lesson is found in Jesus' vulnerability. It is only when we are vulnerable that we learn how to love. When Jesus breathed his last. God's unconditional and tender love was realized. Jesus always had a soft spot for the weak, lost, vulnerable, and broken. God wants us to come to Him freely, not because we have witnessed some fantastic display of prowess. God desires that we find Him through who we are, as our hearts and souls direct. This will mean that our love is authentic as it will be born of the heartache, pain, and turmoil that are a part of life. The fragments of our lives need to be made whole. Our fragmented king, Jesus Christ, is the only one who can help put the pieces together. ©LPi

### **Live the Liturgy**

Our king hangs on a cross. Onlookers saw this as the final defeat of a fool who many saw as an insurrectionist. They laughed at him and challenged his kingship by looking for proof: Save yourself! Historically, earthly kings are influential figures wielding significant power over the quality of their subjects' lives. Where is Jesus' power? Slowly fading away, he's a failure in many eyes. Brokenness and vulnerability are often seen as failures. Something went wrong and exposed us, revealing our fragile and sometimes incorrect selves to others. Yet, what appears at first to be shameful is really a golden key to life. It is only when vulnerable that we learn how to love genuinely. Marking what seems the end of a failed mission, Jesus Christ our King hangs before us as the vulnerable, wounded key to God's infinite love and life. The kingdoms of this world pass away. Jesus hangs as our king of a world that never ends. When we are vulnerable and broken in death, we fall into the fullness of Christ and are made one with him. This is more than any earthly king can promise and is the salvation we seek. ©LPi



### Preparation for Sunday Mass Readings From the Comfort of Home!

### Cycle "A" Year

Our study timeline is to cover the Sunday readings within the seasons of Advent, Christmas, Lent, and Easter. Our preparation goal is to get the most from each Sunday's Word of the Lord at Mass; be more receptive to the Word of God; and experience the Sacrifice of the Mass to its full purpose.

Each Thursday evening we will prepare for the lectionary Bible readings for each Sunday Mass so that our hearts and minds may grow in knowing what it means to have Jesus in our lives.

Together, we will follow Jesus in His earthly journey as we explore the context of the Old and New Testaments, the history of those times, the people, the theme of the combined weekly readings, and more. Our hope is to prepare so we may be more receptive to the Word of God and experience the Sacrifice of the Mass, online or in the sanctuary, to its full purpose.

In our study group we will view a short video presentation from our electronic devices followed by a group discussion and sharing our personal insights.

The video presenter each week is Fr. Hezekias Carnazzo founder of the Institute of Catholic Culture along with a guest on occasion, usually a

Biblical Scholar and/or Theologian.

As an option - not required - for an enhanced study experience, we recommend a great resource book of commentary reflections, The Word of the Lord Sunday Mass Readings, Year "A" a lectionary book written by John Bergsma, PhD., Theologian, Biblical Scholar, and Professor at Franciscan University at Steubenville.

## Is Christ King in Our Hearts?

When you think of a king, who is the first person to pops into your head? It may depend on how much history you know, or which historical period intrigues you the most. As Americans, the first person we might think of is King George III, whose reign has become synonymous in our national lore with the concept of tyranny.

We don't have much familiarity with kingship in modern American society. Kings tend to make us uneasy. Presidents, on the other hand — we can handle those, because we know we are a president's boss. No matter how much power he has, we are the electorate. We are the source of that power. We're comfortable with this arrangement.

But with kings it is profoundly different. Traditionally, the king derives his power from God. His rule bridges humanity with the divine.

We should reflect carefully on whether or not we have made Jesus Christ king in our hearts, or whether we regard him as a president. The difference isn't just one of titles, it's one of roles. Subjects do not demand anything of a king. They beseech. They entreat. They submit, and they accept.

Do we demand of Christ, or do we beseech? Do we tolerate God's edicts with grumbling, or do we embrace His word as the means of our reconciliation with Him?

The "good thief" treated Christ as a king. His counterpart treated him as a president. And it's worth remembering that Jesus Christ is not the President of the Universe.



Las posadas, meaning "the inns," begin on December 16th and continue 9 days until Christmas. The festival is based around a reenactment of Mary and Joseph trying to find lodging at numerous inns and being turned away.

Now, throughout Mexico, children process through their towns as adults follow, carrying candles. The leader of the procession is a child dressed as an angel. A little girl plays Mary and a boy plays Joseph. The other children dress as shepherds and shepherdesses.

The procession goes from house to house, singing Villancicos para pedir posadas (Searching for an Inn). Those in the house sing back, denying the procession lodging. Finally, one innkeeper tells them they can stay in the stable. The doors are open to all at this final house, the Rosary is prayed and a big party begins!

Join St. Peter's parish at a modified Las Posadas held on campus and stay for fellowship and refreshments!



### HISTORICAL MARKER

The following inscription is on the Texas Historical Marker placed at our new property near the corner of Hosack Street & School Street (near the huge vintage oak tree):

### CAMINO REAL DE SAN SABA (CAMINO VIEJO) IN KENDALL COUNTY

Beginning in the 1700s, the Camino Real de San Saba extended northwest from San Antonio through the Comanche and Apachedominated Hill Country to the Spanish fort on the San Saba River named Presidio San Luis de las Amarillas. A portion of the trail was drawn on a Spanish-era map of the San Antonio Presidio in 1767 by Joseph de Urrutia. The path also became known as Camino Viejo (Spanish for "Old Trail") in later documents. The San Saba Presidio officially closed in 1772.

Camino Real de San Saba and the Pinta Trail were two useful pathways into the Hill Country for Spanish entradas, early explorers and later settlers. Early surveyors, including John "Jack" Coffee Hays and John James contributed to the documentation and preservation of the historic road's alignment through their field notes and maps in Kendall County. The Pinta Trail, a few miles to the East, initially overshadowed the Camino San Saba in popularity, but both were used by German settlers from the 1840s onward. Alwin Sorgel recorded in 1847 that "there were two roads from San Antonio into the Grant, the Camino Viejo going in a westerly direction and the Pindas Trail going in a northerly direction. The Indians used these trails for centuries." German cartographer, Hermann Willke, drew an 1850 map depicting both trails. Camino Real San Saba came down this hill and passed a half-mile West of Boerne's Main Plaza, platted in 1852 by partners Gustav Theisen and John James. From there the pathway threaded a pre-Boerne settlement and further North, after going through Spanish Pass, crossed the Guadalupe River where Brownsboro sprang up.


