FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

He was initiated with his first Liturgy Committee Meeting and has been familiarizing himself with his office and files, our Staff and two campuses, the musicians, musical equipment, etc. He has also had the opportunity of meeting a lot of parishioners and musicians/singers after weekend and weekday Masses. He will start playing and singing music this weekend at all Masses. Please welcome Adam to our parish. We anticipate the day drawing closer in which we will have our choirs fully engaged again once we make it through this pandemic and get vaccinations.

***Special thanks to all the musicians and singers who have helped on a regular basis** to provide music in the interim between Joe Cortez resigning his position and Adam Olmos being hired and beginning his work/ministry: Carmen Villareal, Tony Peña, Mike Malone, Rosa Dobies, Jesse Martinez, Francis Booker, Mary Jo Perley, Richard Meneses and those who helped for Spanish Masses: Alfredo Muñoz, Pablo Vargas, Pilar Hernandez, Chelo López. Many other volunteers helped sing and play for Masses, special occasions and concerts that were distributed online. Thanks to each of you. We will give Adam an opportunity to begin leading and being fully introduced to the community. Later he will work out a schedule of music/song leaders.

***All levels of our Faith Formation Programs** have begun again after the Christmas and New Year break. The sessions are being held in a variety of ways to give children/teens and their parents options. Obviously we are having in-class sessions, classes at home, etc. Parents, please make sure your children and teens are registered and participating in sessions that will

deepen their personal relationship with Jesus Christ and learn more about the Church and its teaching and doctrine.

***We recently received further directions from the Archbishop's office regarding the presentation of the Lumen Gentium Award to Megan and Phillip Hunter.** As previously announced, since the pandemic will not allow a large crowded gathering as held yearly at St. Dominic's Parish in San Antonio, the Archbishop is having each pastor present the award in their respective parishes on his behalf. We will be finalizing plans with the Hunters and will announce the date and Mass time at which the awarding will take place.

***Do not forget to sign-up for our Health Screenings** scheduled for February 14th from 8:00 am until 12:00 noon. The screenings are for **cholesterol, diabetes and prostate.** Those taking sign-ups for the next couple of weekends will be either in the courtyard or Narthex depending on the weather. As you know we normally have a larger Health Fair at this time of the year in the Cana Ballroom. Unfortunately the pandemic forced us to scale it back dramatically to only these three health screenings.

***If you want to support the Knights of Columbus** and also make your **Big Bowl weekend of February 7th** easier, then consider pre-registering to have a delicious brisket cooked for you ready for drive-through pick-up. The KCs will be around this weekend after each Mass taking pre-order registrations.

***January 31st through February 6th is Catholic Schools Week** for the Archdiocese of San Antonio. It was initiated last weekend with a pull-out section of the Sunday edition of the *San Antonio Express News*.

The pull-out featured a lot of informational and promotional material regarding elementary, high school and college levels of Catholic education. Please consider sending your children and teens to a Catholic School if you are not already doing it. The rationale for doing so is provided in the publication in the weekend paper, on the Archdiocesan Catholic Schools website, and through each of the individual Catholic educational facilities websites throughout the Archdiocese. ***Our "Stewardship Council,"** formerly known as the **Senior**

Advisory Group (S.A.G.) met this past Tuesday, January 26th, continuing their regular business. Their most recent accomplishment was establishing the new St. Peter's Endowment Fund after a couple who wish to remain anonymous provided the "seed" donation. In a short time, with additional donors, this account already has a balance \$18,318.67. As other new projects and developments are planned by this Council, they will be announced to the entire community.

*Our **2021 Archbishop's Annual Appeal** will begin soon. This year's leaders will again be Greg Jaeger and Jerry Muehlberger. They will be joined by Greg Muenster who will "shadow" them for the entire process this year to be ready to take the place of Greg Jaeger since this is his last year leading. He will then move on to other leadership positions in the parish. Our thanks to each of these men for helping lead this yearly fundraising effort supporting critical ministries of the Archdiocese. Things for the AAA this year are organized a bit differently than in past years. We will be announcing those changes in the near future and making a calendar of events for it public.

***Monsignor Michael "Mike" H. Yarbrough**, a priest of the Archdiocese of San Antonio, died on

January 13th. He retired as Pastor of Holy Trinity Parish in San Antonio in June of 2020. He was ordained for 40 years and served in parishes in the Diocese of Brownsville and the Archdiocese of San Antonio, including St. Matthew's Parish in Jourdanton and at St. Matthew's Parish in San Antonio. Deacon Brad Wakely, our Parish Operations Director, studied for the Permanent Diaconate and served in the parish as an ordained deacon with Msgr. Mike as his mentor and pastor. The funeral service was held at Holy Trinity with burial in Jourdanton this past Monday, January 25th. May he rest in peace.

*Our condolences to the family of **Esther Rangel**. Her services were conducted at St. Peter's Parish this past Wednesday, January 27th at 1:00 pm with burial immediately following. May she see God face-to-face into eternity.

COVID Vaccinations

Many people want access to the Covid-19 vaccine, but availability and access have been problematic nationwide. St. Peter's Parish, along with other ecumenical churches in Boerne, have offered to the officials of the City of Boerne and Kendall County use of their church facilities as venues for distribution of the vaccine IF it becomes available in large quantities. Specifically St. Peter's Parish has offered the use of our Cana Ballroom and, if necessary, our gym for such distribution. A couple of exploratory and planning meetings have been held to be ready IF and WHEN the vaccine becomes available. Should this become a reality here at St. Peter's Parish, we would have a two-day notice to set-up and be ready. St. Peter's would

only serve as a vaccine inoculation site, but the City of Boerne and Kendall County employees would facilitate the registration process and organization/management of the distribution process. Should you be interested in receiving a vaccine you can stay attuned to announcements over the city and county websites. St. Peter's would use its social media avenues to also distribute basic information and how to register. Should this happen, we will also be asking parishioner-volunteers to serve as hospitality, drive golf carts to help handicap people get from the parking lot to the door, etc. We are very fortunate as a parish to be able to offer this service for the good and health of the larger Boerne community.

Safe & Healthy

Just a reminder to all parishioners: Please remain vigilant that when departing the church on Sundays and other events you continue to observe all the Covid-19 safety and health protocols: Social distancing, wearing of masks, no physical contact, etc. I have noticed some people not remaining vigilant enough while visiting outside. I, as everyone, am fatigued by the pandemic restrictions. However, we need everyone's cooperation to retain the health and safety of our entire community.

The nursery is still closed for all Masses, meetings and events until further notice. We apologize for any inconvenience.

This is being done for your health and protection. They are following all CDC guidelines, including the spraying of an approved disinfectant. This is being done for the common good of maintaining public health. Please rest assured we are doing our best to make your church and the campus safe and clean for all gatherings and in worship.

Archbishop's Lumen Gentium Award 2021

St. Peter the Apostle Parish Staff and Pastor announce this year's recipients of the Archbishop's Lumen Gentium Award are **MEGAN & PHILLIP HUNTER**. They came into the Church as a couple through the RCIA process at the Easter Vigil in 2017. They were already active in the parish before that and really "hit the road running" full speed in their commitment and service after the Vigil.

As with most very active parish couples, Megan & Phillip are involved in many ministries and services collaboratively. They work together publicly and many times behind-the-scenes. They also serve in some ministries unique to their own interests, efforts and involvements.

Both Megan & Phillip are very active in the A.C.T.S. Retreats movement, both as retreatants and leaders. As a couple they are central and inspirational leaders of our Kendall County Jail Ministry and the St. Peter's Archdiocesan Kolbe Prison Ministry.

Phillip is a member of the Knights of Columbus and has served as a member of the Parish Pastoral Council for many years. He just began a term this month serving as the Chair of the Pastoral Council.

Megan also serves with the Women's Faith Council and is a participant of our Journey Together Book Club.

Megan & Phillip have worked together as a couple with all the members of the jail and prison ministry and Phillip with the Pastoral Council, providing creative and inspirational leadership orchestrating new ways to be a parish and to minister and serve during the Covid-19 pandemic. For example, with the Kendall County Jail Ministry and Kolbe Prison Ministry, while inmate visitation and ministry have been suspended, they have been instrumental in showing gratitude to the guards and administrative staff hosting large appreciation meals at the Kendall County Jail and at each of the large prisons. Phillip has also worked with the Pastoral Council being creative in service and ministry during the pandemic. This has allowed our parish to flourish through this most challenging time of restrictions and challenges.

Phillip, as the 2020 Pandemic Fall Festival Chair, worked collaboratively with the Fall Festival Committee, especially Edmund & Delma Guerrero, Bubba & Debbie Simnacher, Marco Nuñez, the Knights of Columbus, the Catholic Daughters of America, the Guadalupana Society and Ultreya to creatively organize fundraising and community building events that were pandemic-restriction-resistant. It led to the major success we announced recently in the bulletin.

Megan & Phillip are always ready to help and do many ministries and services behind-the-scenes that we sometimes do not know about unless someone "lets the cat out of the bag!"

Archbishop Gustavo informed all pastors that, due to the increasing cases of Covid-19 infections, he will not hold an Archdiocesan-wide service at St. Dominic's Parish in San Antonio to personally award the individuals or couples being honored as usual. He has delegated each parish to honor the recipients in their own parish at a designated Sunday Mass and have the pastor make the presentation on his behalf. We will announce at a later date the Sunday and time for this award.

Congratulations Megan & Phillip! Thank you for being such committed and true disciples of Jesus Christ inspiring us all! You radiate your love of God and the Church and bring joy to our hearts. Blessings!

You always treated me with respect and kindness. You never made feel like a burden for seeking help. We wish you all a blessed, safe and joyful Christmas. Know that we have given thanks more times than I can count. We pray health, happiness and love over everyone in your community.

We also received a few thank you notes from some of the families. Those were mailed to you. Again, we thank you from the bottom of our hearts for supporting us in this project.

We want to share our end of the year report with you as well. Our fiscal year was from Oct. 1, 2019 through Sept. 30, 2020. We received over \$60,000 from you during this time, and we disbursed over \$45,000. Although the number of calls we received this year were down from the previous year, the amount requested by the family was up almost 20%. Funds were disbursed as follows:

COVID-19 Testing Available

Drive-through Covid testing is being conducted behind the former Rectory building in the parish parking lot between Kronkosky Street and Highland Drive in a **collaborative effort between Kendall County and MD Toxicology Group, LLC**. To be covered for the test by your health insurance, you must have a signed directive from your physician. If you do not have health insurance, cannot personally afford the testing and are a Kendall County resident, go to the Kendall County Emergency Service Office and ask for a voucher from Jeff Fincke. His office is near the freeway on Main Street, located at 1175 North Main Street, Boerne at (830) 249-3721. Tests will be done M-F from 9:00 to 4:00 pm with a 24 hour result. 




