

From the Pastor's Desk

*Again, congratulations to the eighty-four (84) teens and adults of our parish who received the Sacrament of Confirmation last Sunday, April 18th, at the 5:00 pm Mass. Archbishop Gustavo was scheduled to confer the Sacrament, but late in the week his office assistant called to inform us that he could not be here due to severe pain from a back problem. The archbishop delegated Fr. Norman and granted faculties to celebrate the Mass and confer the Sacrament on his behalf. With Covid-19 restrictions reduced, a lot more family members were able to attend in-person in the Sanctuary and many others joined us via livestreaming. Special thanks to Lacey Sorrell and all those who assisted her in instructing everyone in the faith in preparation for this great day in their spiritual development. Thanks, also, to all the Confirmation Sponsors for taking their roles seriously on behalf of those being confirmed. It is a lifelong commitment of spiritual companionship and support.

*Next Saturday and Sunday, May 1st and 2nd, we will be having **First Communions** at the 5:30 pm Mass and the 9:00 am, 11:00 am and 1:00 pm (Spanish) Masses. Please see the accompanying ad on another page of this bulletin for detailed information. This is a great milestone in the children's spiritual development as they join us around the Table of the Lord to receive Jesus in the Sacrament of the Eucharist for the first time. Blessings to each of you and the proud parents and grandparents!

*Next Sunday, May 2nd, we will have our yearly **Graduation Mass** during the Life Teen Mass at 6:00 pm. Please see the accompanying ad on another page of this bulletin with full details. Let's honor our graduating teens to celebrate their accomplishments and pray for their future endeavors that will set the stage for their professional and family lives.

*Because of the incredible generosity of our parishioners, we

continue to make excellent progress in paying-off parish debt on the Family Life Center, the loan to purchase the new property from the Benedictine Sisters, our prorated donation toward the Archbishop's On the Way -¡Andale! Capital Campaign, and the yearly Archbishop's Capital Campaign. At June 30, 2021 we are projected to have a balance of \$398,911.00 on the bond that financed the building of the Family Life Center; the final payment will be made September 15, 2022 (only 17 months from now)! On Monday, April 19th, John Belter, our Chair of the Finance Council, made another early payment of \$40,000.00 on the \$3,942,000.00 loan taken out to purchase the new property. With this latest cash payment from **Combined Capital Campaign** pledges that continue to be fulfilled, our balance due is only \$390.343.00! To date we have also paid \$1,176,074.91 to the Archbishop's Archdiocesan "On the Way - ¡Ándale! Capital Campaign." That is 80% of the total prorated amount due of \$1,568,100.00, leaving a balance due of \$392,025.09. We have made this incredible progress in three years and four months of payments from completed pledges and additional donations for our Combined Capital Campaign. A grand thank you to everyone for your financial support! Special thanks to those individuals and families who are making additional donations and others who are completing pledges with extended payment periods. Should anyone wish to make additional donations to the ongoing Capital Campaign, please contact Fr. Norman, Deacon Brad Wakely or Debra Martini. Blessings to everyone!

*The mass Covid-19 Vaccination Event held on Friday, April 16th, in our Cana Ballroom as a partnership between the City of Boerne, Kendall County & St. Peter's Parish led to approximately 1,300 shots being administered. This past Wednesday, April 21st, was the latest vaccination event. It is anticipated that an approximately equal amount of shots will have been distributed. See an accompanying ad with details for the final vaccination dates available before the effort is turned over to individual doctor's offices, pharmacies, etc.

In the last few vaccination sessions approximately 1,800 shots were administered each time, including first and second doses. Special thanks to all the City and County employees and volunteers and our St. Peter's Parish volunteers who are making this a very professional, hospitable and efficient service. 




