Kolbe Prison Ministry

St. Peter's Parish Cana Ballroom will be the site of the **Kolbe Prison Ministry Annual Conference on July 24th, 2021**. This will be a full-day event including prayers, Mass, talks, etc. for Kolbe prison ministers. Our parishioners, Dr. Jerry Muehlberger, Kathleen Tong, Ed Hoepfner and Phillip Hunter, are on the Conference Planning Team. They can answer any questions you may have about this coming archdiocesan event. Guest Speakers include Fr. George William, S.J., Texas State House Representative Kyle Biedermann, and Fr. Mitch Pacwa, S.J. The day will end with participants joining in our regular Saturday evening Mass at 5:30 pm in the Sanctuary. The Celebrant will be our newly ordained Auxiliary Bishop, Gary Janak. The Mass will be livestreamed to reach a much larger archdiocesan congregation. Further details will be shared later when we get closer to the event.

A special project that Phillip Hunter and Dr. Jerry Muehlberger are working on is a **Volunteer Recruitment video for the Kolbe Prison Ministry**. The Texas Department of Criminal Justice (TDCJ) agreed to allow Deacon Bob Liebrecht, Prison Chaplain for the Archdiocese of San Antonio, Jerry and Phillip to film and interview inside the Torres Unit as long as they respect the privacy of the inmates by not filming their faces. The video is still being developed and will be available for the Conference and the larger Archdiocese Kolbe Prison Ministry Teams. Congratulations to these two very committed and creative members of our parish.

St. Peter's Parish Kendall County Jail Ministry

Gloria Villaneuva received word from Sgt. Barter that the **Kendall County Jail Ministry can re-open**. Our Jail Ministry Team plans to begin sessions at the previously regularly scheduled dates and times for men and women inmates in May. We will be working on getting team members to recommit now that we are coming out of the pandemic. We hope to have a re-organizing meeting with the team at the soonest possible convenience. Did you know that about 1 in 5 kids in Boerne is classified as "food insecure"? This means that they can not count on three nutritious meals a day. The federal free and reduced lunch program helps them during the school day, and organizations like Blessings in a Backpack help feed them on the weekends during the school year... but what about the summer months? This is where the Boerne Community Coalition comes in. Our mission is to improve the quality of life for children and families in our community by creating, connecting, and providing them with needed resources and services.

Please buy a HEB card (or an extra HEB card) after Mass and place it in the donation bin right next to the card sales cart. These donations will be used to buy fresh produce to feed the children in need all summer long. Your generosity is appreciated!



Payment of Church Debt: A Progress Report

Because of the incredible generosity of our parishioners, we continue to make excellent progress in paying-off parish debt on the Family Life Center, the loan to purchase the new property from the Benedictine Sisters, our prorated donation toward the Archbishop's On the Way - ¡Ándale! Capital Campaign, and the yearly Archbishop's Capital Campaign.

At June 30, 2021 we are projected to have a balance of \$398,911.00 on the bond that financed the building of the Family Life Center; the final payment will be made September 15, 2022 (only 17 months from now)! On Monday, April 19th, John Belter, our Chair of the Finance Council, made another early payment of \$40,000.00 on the \$3,942,000.00 loan taken out to purchase the new property. With this latest cash payment from Combined Capital Campaign pledges that continue to be fulfilled, our balance due is only \$390,343.00!

To date we have also paid \$1,176,074.91 to the Archbishop's Archdiocesan "On the Way - ¡Ándale! Capital Campaign." That is 80% of the total prorated amount due of \$1,568,100.00, leaving a balance due of \$392,025.09.

We have made this incredible progress in three years and four months of payments from completed pledges and additional donations for our Combined Capital Campaign.

A grand thank you to everyone for your financial support! Special thanks to those individuals and families who are making additional donations and others who are completing pledges with extended payment periods.
