Live Streaming Masses to Continue

Some parishes are discontinuing live streaming their weekend Masses to encourage parishioners to return to services in their church Sanctuaries. This is the ideal—to be gathered in person in community for the celebration of Sunday Mass. Here at St. Peter's Parish we encourage all of our parishioners to return to Masses as well, if you are physically capable. At the same time, we learned that our live-streamed Masses serve a population in our parish that had been unserved in the past—those who are in nursing homes or assisted living facilities or are shut-ins in their own homes or that of relatives. They can now join us for Mass via live streaming. We have also learned that former parishioners who have moved away join us online for weekend Masses because they miss our community and that parishioners who are traveling also join us online. People curious about and interested in Catholicism also go online to our parish website to experience our community and worship. Live streaming serves as a significant evangelization tool and process. In light of all these insights, we made a decision as a pastoral staff to continue live streaming Masses and making it part of our new ministry called the "St. Peter's Online Parish Community." Everyone needs to be reassured things will remain the same. However, if you are physically capable, you and your family should return to Masses with the parish community and receive sacramental Communion. Remember this is a spiritual obligation as a Catholic! Nothing can replace communal celebration of the Mass. Welcome back!

Homebound Eucharistic Ministers Needed

Eucharistic Ministers to the Sick take communion to those who cannot attend Mass because of illness, injury, or age issues. These ministers bring Christ in the comfort and strength of the Eucharist during difficult times in their lives. They minister to people in their homes, in nursing homes, assisted living facilities, and retirement communities within our parish.

How much time is involved?

Time commitment for this ministry varies by situation and minister. Some commitments last only a few weeks, e.g., while a parishioner is recovering from surgery or is in hospice, while others can last for years. Some serve once a week or month at a nursing home or retirement community. Ministers choose the commitments that fit their work schedule and family needs. We firmly believe that the Holy Spirit guides our Minister to the homebound parishioner who needs them the most. You can expect to spend 15 – 20 minutes per visit.

What is required?

The love of taking Christ to our suffering brothers and sisters. If you are interested in becoming a Eucharistic Minister to the Sick, please contact the parish office or Michelle Lee at (210) 831-6454 or odysseylee11@hotmail.com. Training sessions for this ministry are generally held as needed or when there is enough interest so watch the bulletin or this website for dates and times. Ministers to the Sick will need to complete a background check, receive safe environment training, receive training as Eucharistic Ministers and also receive ministry-specific training.

²⁶ We begin our profession of faith by saying: "I believe" or "We believe". Before expounding the Church's faith, as confessed in the Creed, celebrated in the liturgy and lived in observance of God's commandments and in prayer, we must first ask what "to believe" means. Faith is man's response to God, who reveals himself and gives himself to man, at the same time bringing man a superabundant light as he searches for the ultimate meaning of his life. Thus we shall consider first that search (Chapter One), then the divine Revelation by which God comes to meet man (Chapter Two), and finally the response of faith (Chapter Three).





Why Spiritual Direction?


Spiritual Direction is setting aside time to explore the actions of God in your life. During hard times and good times, we need to see where God is in our lives. The more we see Him in our everyday lives, the better we grow in our relationship with Him.

When we see a Spiritual Director, it is one Christian to another Christian, sharing personal experiences about God in our lives. We discern what God is saying to us, what He wants us to do. We start with a prayer and ask the Holy Spirit to be with us. The Holy Spirit is present, and He guides us as we speak. He is the one in charge. He is the true Spiritual Director.

A Spiritual Director listens with sacred presence and attends to the entire person. A Spiritual Director offers a gentle, confidential and nonjudgmental place of welcome.

Here at St. Peter's Parish, we have six Spiritual Directors who meet with people by phone, Zoom or in person. We are using the COVID-19 precautions. We want anyone who comes to us to feel comfortable. Our directors are Bonnie Caruso, Maryann Hawn, Hector Lopez, Deacon Ken Nickels, Dorene Oesterreicher and Kelly Ward. We also welcome our three new directors who finished their three years of formation in this month—Brian Hammer, Leroy Ferry and Elizabeth Nolen.


Kolbe Prison Ministry

Our parishioners, Dr. Jerry Muehlberger, Kathleen Tong, Ed Hoepfner and Phillip Hunter, are on the Conference Planning Team. They can answer any questions you may have about this coming archdiocesan event. Guest Speakers include Fr. George William, S.J., Texas State House Representative Kyle Biedermann, and Fr. Mitch Pacwa, S.J. The day will end with participants joining in our regular Saturday evening Mass at 5:30 pm in the Sanctuary. The Celebrant will be our newly ordained Auxiliary Bishop, Gary Janak. 
