St. Peter the Apostle Catholic School Feasibility Study

A PRAYERFUL & SPIRITUAL DISCERNMENT PROCESS

It is not a given that we are building a Catholic school in Boerne. It is an idea and a proposal with significant "seed money" supporting it. However, an informed decision will have to be made before possibly moving forward. Meitler, the Catholic schools consulting firm hired to do the School Feasibility Study, is playing a central role in gathering pertinent information from demographics, interviews, etc., to make recommendations to the Archdiocese, St. Peter's Parish and the Donor. This is a rather slow and arduous process.

As stated before, Meitler's commitment and responsibility is to conduct a thorough, objective and transparent study so all parties that have a vested interest in the findings and recommendations make a wise and informed decision for the good of Catholic school education within the Archdiocese of San Antonio, and specifically for the future of St. Peter's Parish. On average, in previous studies done, Meitler recommends that a school can be built successfully in 60% of cases and not built in 40% of situations.

When recommending that a school can be opened, Meitler's professional reputation as a consulting firm is based on their study's findings and recommendations being followed closely by dioceses and donors, leading to the long-term success of the school. When recommending that a school not be opened, Meitler presents findings showing that a possible school does not have the proper and adequate demographic, parishioner and donor support behind it. Again, the point is that it is not a given that St. Peter's Parish is building a Catholic school. We must await the findings and possibly have much broader and deeper discussions in the future regarding size, cost, etc.

It would be irresponsible to rely solely on the Meitler School Feasibility Study process and findings/recommendations to lead us to the answer of whether or not to build a school. Above all, this whole experience and study must be, at its root, a parish-wide experience of reflection and prayer, and a spiritual discernment process. We need to discern God's will about this matter.

One of Meitler's specific expectations of the fifteen members of the Steering Committee is that they prayerfully seek God's desire for the ministry of Catholic school education in the Archdiocese and specifically at St. Peter's Parish in Boerne. The broader reality is that every parish family and individual parishioner is expected to be a part of this endeavor by prayer, reflection, discernment, and participation in asking questions and providing feedback, insights and direction when given the opportunity by Meitler.

As pastor, I ask you to join me in setting this spiritual focus for the School Feasibility Study. Mary Ann Hawn, a former St. Peter's Staff member, graciously wrote a special St. Peter's Parish Prayer for the success of the Feasibility Study. We have printed the prayer here in the bulletin immediately following this article. Within a couple of weeks we will print special prayer cards with a cover image and the prayer printed on the back side. The prayer cards will be distributed after weekend Masses in the near future. Please personally say this special prayer once a day along with all other parishioners of St. Peter's Community.


We invite you to pray in many other ways that our Catholic traditions provide, all with the intention of the School Feasibility Study: Mass attendance, Rosaries, Divine Mercy Chaplets, Novenas, time in Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, periods of spontaneous personal reflection and prayer, and your active engagement in the whole study process. We seek the movement of God's Spirit within our community over these remaining four plus months of the study. Let us also engage one another in conversation about the idea of a school and where we stand about it. As a parish we need to discern in what way a Catholic school could fit into our present parish history and Parish Pastoral Plan. All of us need to have a long-range vision for St. Peter's Parish to make a mature and wise decision to move forward with building or not.

Remember, the true spiritual focus of this whole process are the children and parents of our Catholic families. It is an opportunity to form them for a lifetime in their intellectual, faith, moral/ethical, spiritual and ecclesial/pastoral

growth. The mission of a Catholic school is to evangelize children and their parents, and to form the children as the next generation of Catholics and leaders in society. We ask that parents with school-aged children take a special and pro-active role in this study and prayer. Ask yourselves if you are totally satisfied with the education your children are receiving wherever they go to school in Boerne. Is there something special and unique that an authentically Catholic school might offer your children as they grow and mature? Pray together as a family about the possibilities offered by a Catholic school here in Boerne.

Whatever your personal position about a Catholic school, open your hearts and minds about it. Pray together that God's will be done in this whole matter. It is said that: When we do our part, God does his part! Let us trust this process, pray fervently, participate wholeheartedly, and grow spiritually together as a parish. We pray: "Come Holy Spirit, come, fill the hearts of your faithful," guide us in this process and lead us to the answer that is true to your divine will for St. Peter's Parish in this particular moment in its history. Thank you and God bless you!

Some parishes are discontinuing live streaming their weekend Masses to encourage parishioners to return to services in their church Sanctuaries. This is the ideal—to be gathered in person in community for the celebration of Sunday Mass. Here at St. Peter's Parish we encourage all of our parishioners to return to Masses as well, if you are physically capable. At the same time, we learned that our live-streamed Masses serve a population in our parish that had been unserved in the past—those who are in nursing homes or assisted living facilities or are shut-ins in their own homes or that of relatives. They can now join us for Mass via live streaming. We have also learned that former parishioners who have moved away join us online for weekend Masses because they miss our community and that parishioners who are traveling also join us online. People curious about and interested in Catholicism also go online to our parish website to experience our community and worship. Live streaming serves as a significant evangelization tool and process. In light of all these insights, we made a decision as a pastoral staff to continue live streaming Masses and making it part of our new ministry called the 'St. Peter's Online Parish Community." Everyone needs to be reassured things will remain the same. However, if you are physically capable, you and your family should return to Masses with the parish community and receive sacramental Communion. Remember this is a spiritual obligation as a Catholic! Nothing can replace communal celebration of the Mass. Welcome back!







Estudio de viabilidad de San Pedro Apóstol sobre una escuela católica

DESARROLLAR UNA VISIÓN

Poco después de que el Sr. Clarence Kahlig hiciera la oferta de un importante "capital inicial" para abrir una escuela católica en Boerne, estaba convencido de que la cosa más importante y fundamental que debía considerarse al principio del proceso de discernimiento era el desarrollo de un borrador de trabajo formal de la Visión. En el mercado educativo altamente competitivo de Boerne, necesitaremos desarrollar una Visión que ofrezca algo acumulativamente único más allá de lo que las instituciones educativas ya ofrecen en el área y en otras escuelas Católicas de la Arquidiócesis de San Antonio. Tendrá que ser una escuela especial de alta calidad para convencer a los padres de que paguen una matrícula significativa para que sus hijos asistan.

Las cosas más convincentes que la Arquidiócesis de San Antonio y la Parroquia de San Pedro tienen para ofrecer incluyen: 1.) nuestra larga historia internacional en educación católica desde Pre-K hasta estudios universitarios y de posgrado; 2.) nuestros estudios bíblicos católicos únicos y altamente desarrollados, historia, tradiciones, teología, sacramentos, moral / ética, espiritualidad, enseñanzas sociales y práctica pastoral; y, 3) que también damos la bienvenida al registro de niños de la comunidad ecuménica en general. Estas contribuciones serán fundamentales para la Visión, pero abarcarán muchas otras facetas necesarias para ser competitivo.

Es importante señalar que, como han dicho los representantes de Meitler, no estamos tratando de competir o imitar lo que ya ofrecen otras instituciones educativas en Boerne y la Arquidiócesis. Queremos que todos prosperen con sus misiones especiales y tengan éxito por derecho propio. Necesitamos visualizar y construir algo único y diferente de lo que ya se está ofreciendo y que encaje en la misión evangelizadora del sistema escolar católico y la Iglesia Católica universal. Obviamente habrá similitudes y superposiciones con lo que ofrecen otras escuelas de la zona como excelentes académicos, instalaciones de alta calidad, etc. Sin embargo, debemos ser capaces de articular de forma clara y eficaz lo que nos distingue de otras instituciones educativas de la zona.

El desarrollo de esta Visión será responsabilidad principal del Comité Directivo. En su Visita #1 hace dos semanas, las representantes de Meitler, la Sra. Gunderson y la Sra. Schram, entregaron un formulario titulado "Temas de discusión sobre la visión". Incluye una explicación del proceso de establecimiento de la Visión y preguntas importantes que cada miembro debe responder y enviar. Las áreas de enfoque a considerar incluyen, pero no se limitan a: la identidad católica de la escuela, la filosofía y la vida de la escuela; currículo y ofertas académicas; oportunidades primarias y competencia por la inscripción; elementos únicos o nicho para distinguir la escuela; actividades extracurriculares y programas diferenciadores; ofertas deportivas; conexión entre la escuela y la parroquia de San Pedro; y objetivos de inscripción óptimos cuando esté en pleno funcionamiento.

Los representantes de Meitler compilarán un borrador de trabajo de Visión de todas las respuestas del Comité enviadas. El borrador se utilizará para la discusión del Comité Directivo en la Visita #2 que se llevará a cabo en la primera semana de agosto. Una vez que el Comité apruebe un borrador de trabajo de Visión, se utilizará en todas las discusiones, entrevistas, encuestas y correspondencia futuras. Para que el estudio de viabilidad proporcione información válida y útil, no puede basarse en una visión genérica, sino en un borrador de trabajo específico de la Visión al que todos los encuestados pueden reaccionar y basarse en ello, lo que conducirá a un mayor refinamiento y finalización de la Visión.

Homebound Eucharistic Ministers Needed

Eucharistic Ministers to the Sick take communion to those who cannot attend Mass because of illness, injury, or age issues. These ministers bring Christ in the comfort and strength of the Eucharist during difficult times in their lives. They minister to people in their homes, in nursing homes, assisted living facilities, and retirement communities within our parish.

How much time is involved?

Time commitment for this ministry varies by situation and minister. Some commitments last only a few weeks, e.g., while a parishioner is recovering from surgery or is in hospice, while others can last for years. Some serve once a week or month at a nursing home or retirement community. Ministers choose the commitments that fit their work schedule and family needs. We firmly believe that the Holy Spirit guides our Minister to the homebound parishioner who needs them the most. You can expect to spend 15 – 20 minutes per visit.

What is required?

The love of taking Christ to our suffering brothers and sisters.
