5. What would a Catholic school have to offer or accomplish in order for you to enroll your children? What would you expect a high-quality Catholic school to look like and be like? What features are essential (must have), and which would be nice to have? Please explain.
6. What could/should a new school program offer that is not currently offered by other schools (including Catholic schools) in the area?
7. If the cost of tuition was not a reason to prevent you from enrolling, would you enroll your child? Why? Why not?
8. What are the one or two big questions you would need answered before you would enroll at a new Catholic school?
9. What advice do you have for the diocesan and parish leadership if they decide to move forward in planning and opening a new Catholic school?

7. What level of support (spiritual, moral, financial) do you think the parish and Catholic community of Boerne might have for such an undertaking? What level of support would you expect and want from the parish and Catholic community to make this a viable and sustainable reality?
8. What advice do you have for the diocesan and parish leadership if they decide to move forward with planning and opening a new Catholic school?
9. What issues or questions would you like to see addressed in a market research survey with parents and parishioners that will be conducted as part of this study?
