- \*Thank you to all parishioners who have made pledges in support of our Capital Campaign. Please notice the thermometer's posted at the doors of the church reflecting the latest pledged amount to date. If each family of the parish made a pledge according to their means, after prayer and reflection on sacrificial giving, we would be unbelievably successful allowing St. Peter's to build for the future with our strategically set vision and mission. We presently stand on the shoulders of many generous Catholics of the past who gave and built St. Peter's to be what it is today. Now we are at the threshold of rapid and unprecedented growth in our parish history. This Campaign provides an invitation and opportunity for each family of the parish to be part of something bigger than themselves, with incredible meaning and purpose in promoting the faith, and nurturing the spiritual lives of Catholics in Boerne and the Hill Country for centuries to come.
- \*If you receive a call or correspondence asking you to complete your pledge from one of our Capital Campaign Volunteers, it is simply meant to help remind you and facilitate completion of the pledge card. Some may experience this as assertive or even aggressive. Human nature is to set aside such appeals or even forget them even when we intend to follow through with a commitment. The volunteer calls or contacts are meant to be a reminder and inspiration to join our parish family in this community-wide effort of generosity. We assure you that all volunteers have been instructed to respect confidentiality: None of them know the "ask" amount or the actual amount you are pledging and the volunteer is to provide an envelope to seal your pledge card in when you give it to them. Some of you voiced your preference to hand your pledge in on your own by taking it to the office, dropping it in the collection basket or mailing it. If you prefer that, please tell the volunteer who may call you that that is your preference.
- \*Approximately 475 parish ministry volunteers enjoyed the **Appreciation Dinner** hosted last Friday evening in the Cana Ballroom. This event shows our gratitude for the countless hours of outreach our parishioners do on behalf of our Catholic faith and parish community.
- \*Last Saturday morning a Prayer Service was conducted at 416 W. Highlands Street with representatives of the Benedictine Sisters and St. Peter's Parish, marking the transition of ownership of the property. Those representing the parish were: The Parish Staff, Finance Council, Special Committee (who studied the feasibility of purchasing the property), the Pastoral Council and Fr. Tony and Fr. Norman. This was our mutual way of celebrating the past, present, and future, thanking God, and focusing on our mutual ministry in the service of the Gospel in Boerne. The Benedictine Sisters will sponsor the planting of a new tree on the property and the parish will install a historical plaque listing property owners over the years and a thank you to the Benedictines for their making the property available.
- \*Thank you to the 30+ men and women of the parish who volunteered helping complete the clean out of buildings, trimming trees and brush and other tasks sprucing up the Benedictine property. Several teams of volunteer clean-up crews had been there before as well cleaning trash, trimming, raking leaves, etc. They included members of the family of Terise Bransford, our Pastoral Administrator. Our special thanks to Rick Martini, our Facilities Manager, who has organized and orchestrated these work days and all the repairs and renovations being done to ready the facility for parish use.
- \*We have hosted several presentations, light meals and tours of the Benedictine property for parishioners. More are yet to come as announced. Last Sunday a meal, presentation and tour was provided for approximately 200 members of the St. Peter's Spanish speaking community regarding the Benedictine Property. Thank you to all the volunteers who served as chefs, servers, hospitality, presenters, tour guides, etc. Special thanks to Ernesto Castillo who served as the presenter and translator, assisting Fr. Norman and Rodeana Reynolds, the Events Chair for the Campaign who, with her committee, planned and orchestrated the event. There will be an Open House and tour of the New Property on February 11 at 3:00 pm.

# St. Peter's Combined CAMPAIGN UJJOUTC

#### From the Pastor's Desk Combined Capital Campaign Update

**ROLE OF THE VOLUNTEER** We are fortunate to have about 55 volunteers placing phone calls to parishioners to set up appointments for the combined capital campaign.

Many are asking, "Why am I getting a phone call", and "What is the role of these volunteers?"

The volunteers' job is simply to make an appointment with you, then explain the goals of the campaign, answer any questions you may have, and get you to complete your pledge card. We make these appointments for a very good reason.

Our campaign consultant, the Steier Group, has demonstrated to the campaign committee the importance of making personal visits with the parishioners. Once a parishioner has talked with a volunteer, they have a better understanding of what is being accomplished and the importance of the projects to the parish.

After prayerfully considering the request amount, which was included in the letter I mailed to you in mid-January, parishioners tend to make pledges that are truly meaningful and sacrificial.

The request amount is not an expectation, but rather, an invitation to discern what is right and proper, in other words meaningful and sacrificial, for each household. Only through prayer and the guidance of the Holy Spirit will you be able to discern that amount.

If that amount is the request amount—wonderful. If that amount is greater than the request amount—wonderful. If that amount is less than the request amount—wonderful. Any amount discerned through prayer and guidance of the Holy Spirit is always the right amount.

So, please be kind when your volunteer calls you to set up an appointment. Help them so they can help you.

**PONDER THIS** A greedy, rich man hired a great mathematician to find the best way for him to make the greatest profit in everything he did. The rich man was building a huge safe, and his greatest dream was to fill it with gold and jewels.

After months of analysis, the mathematician appeared at the rich man's house, with a big smile on his face: "I found it!" he said, "My calculations are perfect." 



# CATECHESIS OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD

3 year olds—5th Grade

The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is a Montessori-based religious formation for 3-12 year olds. It seeks to create and facilitate a sacred, "hands-on" space called an atrium, in which both the children and the catechists can hear, ponder, and celebrate the most essential mysteries of the Christian faith as revealed in the scriptures and the liturgy.

The themes presented in the atrium are those to which the children have responded with depth and joy. These themes are taken from the Bible and the liturgy (prayers and sacraments) as the fundamental sources for creating and sustaining Christian life at every developmental stage and, for illuminating and nourishing the child's most vital religious needs.

For the Parishioner: The children respond with a particular joy to the themes presented in the Atrium. It is not a joy that produces an emotional excitement, which leads to fatigue and irritability. Rather it is a joy that makes them peaceful, relaxed and involves the child completely. How does/can your community support CGS so that all the children have an opportunity to experience this joy?

<u>For the Parent:</u> Sofia Cavalletti, founder of the CGS, notes that just as increased height and weight are signs that the child's physical needs have been met, joy is the sign that a child's spiritual needs are being met. *How have you seen that your child's religious needs are being met?* 

For the Catechist: When have you seen a child respond in joy this year? What vital need was being met that led to this response? To what was the child responding, i.e. scripture proclamation, gesture, time at the prayer table, silence game, working with materials, etc.?







## **Adult Enrichment**

Ongoing Conversion to Jesus Promoting/Supporting Active Fellowship Forming Disciples in Mission to the World

On the 40th Day After Christmas.
The Feast of the Purification

(Candlemas)

If you have participated in any of our Adult Bible and Faith Studies, you probably have come across the feast day of the purification of Mary and the presentation of our Lord in some of them, as well as in our annual liturgical celebration of this feast day.

In the times of Jesus birth, the Mosaic law required a woman who had given birth to a male child to refrain from entering the temple for "3 and 30 days," in addition to the 7 days after giving birth to a man-child. The woman was considered unclean until that time

To be clean again and be "purified" the mother had to take to the temple, "a lamb for a holocaust and a young pigeon or turtle dove for sin". If she didn't have a lamb then she could bring "two turtle doves" or "two pigeons" and the priest would pray over her for her purification.

Forty days after the birth of Christ Mary complied with this precept of the law and was purified by the prayer of a priest. It was also Christ's first entry into the temple, the presentation of the Lord, \*the first born who belonged to the Lord.

In Luke 2:34-35 Simeon gave his prophecy to Mary where he told "her heart would be pierced with a sword." He also referred to her Infant Son as the Light to the revelation of the Gentiles, and because of this, light reference, candles play an important role before and during the Mass. Hence, the most common name for this Feast -- "Candlemas."

Learn More: Place yourself in this story and ritual as you read and reflect on the following verses in the Bible: Leviticus 12:2-8; Luke 2:22-24; Exodus 13:2, 12-13, Numbers 18:15-16, and Luke 2:34-35

\*Note that "firstborn" means "the male child that opens the womb," not "the first of a series of children born." Therefore, the objections to Mary's eternal virginity based on references to Jesus as "firstborn" are totally without foundation.




