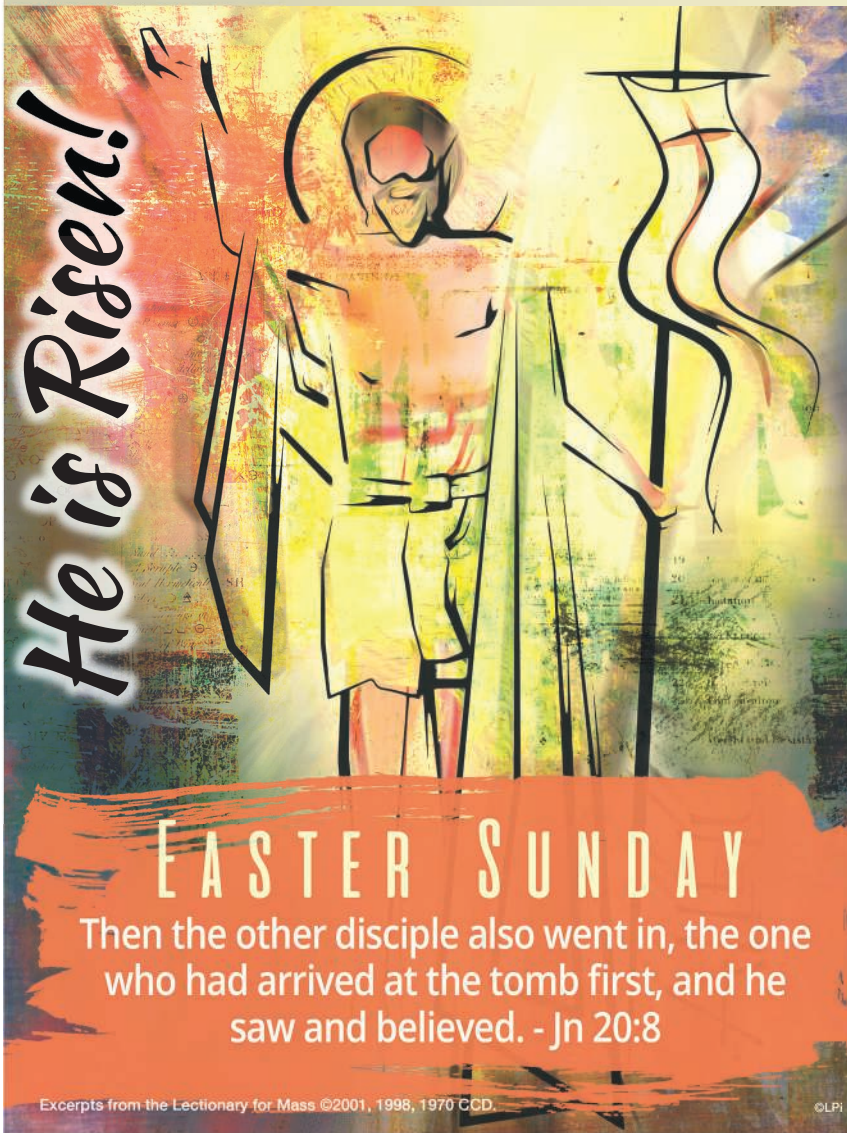

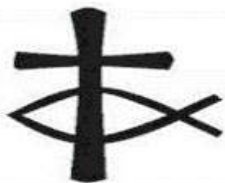

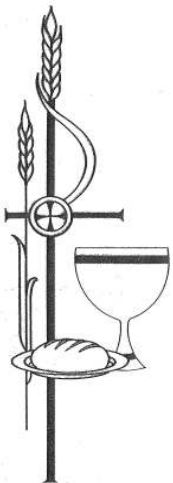
The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is a Montessori-based religious formation for 3-12 year olds. It seeks to create and facilitate a sacred, "hands-on" space called an atrium, in which both the children and the catechists can hear, ponder, and celebrate the most essential mysteries of the Christian faith as revealed in the scriptures and the liturgy.

City of Jerusalem

Sofia Cavalletti and Gianna Gobbi understood the importance of knowing about the Holy Land in order to grasp the message of the Bible. There is no history without its geography. She wrote, "In our view it is important that the historical events also have materials relative to their geographical reconstruction in order to let the children know how to situate them in a point in space. The material helps to concretize the events." (*Religious Potential of the Child*, p 113)

After the children are oriented to the city, the catechist shows more details, including: the pools, the Temple, the Cenacle, Garden of Gethsemane, House of Caiaphas, Tower of Antonia, Herod's Palace, the Cross & the Empty Tomb. At home, **read the following scripture** and invite your children to listen for the names of cities, towns and other places mentioned in the scripture readings during Lent:

- Jesus being tempted by Satan, taken to the parapet of the temple.
- Jesus drives the money-changers from the temple
- Jesus heals the man born blind, sending him
- to wash at the Pool of Siloam
- The Pharisees confront Jesus at the temple
- Passion of Jesus
- Jesus washes the disciple's feet at the Cenacle
- Jesus' Resurrection or discovery of the Empty Tomb

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd Director

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS) is a Montessori based approach to the religious formation of Children based on the premise that there already exists a deep and unique bond between God and the child. We meet each week in the 'atrium' or sacred space, which is more like a retreat center than a classroom. There, our goal is to foster and deepen the child's relationship with God, to encourage the formation of a personal prayer life, to help the child participate more fully in the liturgical and sacramental life of the Church, and to develop a deeper understanding of the Catholic identity and tradition.

REQUIREMENTS

Full-time director; this position requires approximately 40 hours per week, including Sundays, occasional evenings/weekends, and special events as required.

OBJECTIVES

This position is responsible for coordinating Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (3yrs-12yrs of age) Faith Formation at St. Peter the Apostle Catholic Church. Responsibilities include (but are not limited to) child enrollment and class scheduling, atrium and materials maintenance, scheduling and organizing catechist volunteers and formation courses.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Must have experience with and passion for working with children and their families.
- Candidate should have knowledge and understanding of the teachings of the Roman Catholic Church.

- CGS certification is required, otherwise commitment to complete CGS certification for Levels 1, 2 and 3.
- Candidate should have a regular personal practice of prayer, study, worship, and stewardship.
- Must have excellent interpersonal and communication skills; must be a relationship-builder and possess an engaging personality.
- Required to work with staff, clergy, and parish volunteers.
