

#### THE CHAPLET OF DIVINE MERCY

and it's promises

SUNDAY, April 8th is Divine Mercy Sunday. Join us at 3pm in the main sanctuary as we immerse ourselves in His great mercy.

Jesus said, "My daughter, encourage souls to say the chaplet which I have given you. It pleases Me to grant everything they ask of Me

by saying the chaplet. When hardened sinners say it, I will fill their souls with peace, and the hour of their death will be a happy one.

The three o'clock hour is the hour of great mercy. This is the hour Our Lord died on the cross. The Lord invites us to pray this chaplet at (3:00) every afternoon, remembering Christ's death on the cross.

- 1. "The souls that say this chaplet will be embraced by My mercy during their lifetime and especially at the hour of their death" (Diary, 754).
- 2. "When hardened sinners say it, I will fill their souls with peace, and the hour of their death will be a happy one" (Diary, 1541).
- 3. "When they say this chaplet in the presence of the dying, I will stand between My Father and the dying person, not as a just Judge but as a merciful Savior" (Diary, 1541).
- 4. "Whoever will recite it will receive great mercy at the hour of death" (Diary, 687).
- 5. "Priests will recommend it to sinners as their last hope of salvation. Even if there were a sinner most hardened, if he were to recite this chaplet only once, he would receive grace from My infinite mercy... I desire to grant unimaginable graces to those souls who trust in My mercy" (Diary, 687).
- 6. "To priests who proclaim and extol My mercy, I will give wondrous power; I will anoint their words and touch the hearts of those to whom they will speak" (Diary, 1521).
- 7. "The prayer most pleasing to Me is prayer for the conversion for sinners. Know, my daughter, that this prayer is always heard and answered" (Diary, 1397).
- 8. "At three o'clock, implore My mercy, especially for sinners; and, if only for a brief moment, immerse yourself in My Passion, particularly in My abandonment at the moment of agony... I will refuse nothing to the soul that makes a request of Me in virtue of My Passion" (Diary, 1320; also, cf. Diary, 1572).
- 9. "Souls who spread the honor of My mercy... at the hour of death I will not be a Judge for them, but the Merciful Savior" (Diary, 1075).
- 10. "I promise that the soul that will venerate this image (of the Divine Mercy) will not perish" (Diary, 48)... "The two rays denote Blood and Water... These two rays issued from the very depths of My tender mercy when My agonized Heart was opened by a lance on the Cross. These rays shield souls from the wrath of My Father" (Diary, 299).
- 11. "I desire that the Feast of Mercy... be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter... The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion (in a state of grace on this day) shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment" (Diary, 699).
- 12. "Through this chaplet you will obtain everything, if what you ask for is compatible with My will" (Diary, 1731). For more info about Divine Mercy visit: www.thedivinemercy.org.



#### **FAITH FORMATION**

#### Meditation

Should we be a little easier on Thomas? The last few days have been a whirlwind. On Thursday, a Passover celebration went horribly awry as Jesus was betrayed and taken into custody for unstated crimes. Fewer than 24 hours later, a simple arrest has turned into a death sentence to be carried out that very afternoon. Most of the disciples fled, including Thomas. He would have heard of the events of Good Friday secondhand, in shock over the death of his Lord and Master. Then Sunday morning arrives with joy from a few disciples-Jesus is risen! But there is no persistent sight of him, only Mary Magdalene's quick moment in the garden and an empty tomb. Another day passes. The Apostles are gathered that Monday night, but Thomas is absent. He returns to a jubilant report of the risen Lord. Again, Thomas has seen nothing.

The experience must have been surreal. Did Jesus really appear raised from the dead? Did he really suffer and die? Has all of this been some strange hoax? Desperate for an answer, Thomas insists, "Unless I see the mark of the nails in his hands and put my finger into the nail marks and put my hand into his side, I will not believe."

After his resurrection, Jesus' body--mangled and bloody from the crucifixion--is restored. Did it need the scars? A perfected body would have taught us one lesson: everything is renewed as it once was, the past erased. Jesus chooses another lesson, however. He retains his scars that we might know him. In the whirlwind of our lives, we make our own mistakes, our own betrayals and compromises. In the resurrected Jesus, we see a God who does not forget his own sorrow. We are invited to meet him--wound for wound--and place our hand on his own nail-scarred palm, the eternal sign of his everlasting mercy.

The prophets of the Old Testament hold a fascination for us all. Do we really know them? Who they were? Where they came from? and especially, Why they were so important then and remain so now? We read an excerpt from one of the prophets at mass almost every day, so they must have some significance.

We vaguely recall the fiery message of the prophets of Israel – repent of your evil ways or the God of your forefathers, of Abraham, Issac and Jacob will wreak his vengeance on you. But was this really their only message? Do they have something more relevant to say to us living as Catholics in the 21st century? Why do we still read these prophets today at nearly every Mass?

Lots of questions to be answered! Come join us and we will explore their message both for the Israelites of their day and for us. How did the prophets who spoke 400-800 years before him prefigure Jesus' coming as the Messiah, as suffering servant to his people, to establish a new covenant with us which we celebrate each day?



#### BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS) is a Montessori based approach to the religious formation of Children based on the premise that there already exists a deep and unique bond between God and the child. 




