As you will recall, we assisted Fr. David financially when he was beginning to build the new parish, Our Lady of Guadalupe, in Lubbock, Texas. Please set aside these three days to grow spiritually and to be inspired.

+We continue our focus on the **2020 Archbishop's Annual Appeal (A.A.A.)** this weekend in preparation for the "In Pew" weekend next week, Saturday and Sunday, February 22-23rd. Most, if not all of you, who are registered families of our parish have already received the Archbishop's Appeal letter, pledge card and envelope in your mailbox. If you are not registered, then you will be given an opportunity to pledge with materials provided for your use by our leaders, Greg Jaeger & Dr. Jerry Muehlberger and their assistants. The prorated goal for St. Peter's Parish is \$153,100.71. Thanks to those parishioners who have already returned your completed pledge. Let us all be generous and increase the number of families pledging.

+Our **St. Peter's Health Fair** last Sunday was a success due to the organization and hard work of **Barbara Walz and Greg Gonyer**. This year we made available health screenings for blood sugar, cholesterol and P.S.A. A

total of 74 parishioners took at least two of the tests for a total of 181 screenings. There were 18 booths set-up for parishioners to learn from the professionals present. Thanks to everyone for your help and participation.

+Our **Senior Advisory Group (S.A.G.)** continues to oversee our Stewardship program and progress and is deliberating about governance structure changes and plans for our parish for the future. **Syd Muenster**, one of the members of the S.A.G., informed Fr. Norman this past Monday that she will be resigning from her position at this juncture of the Group's work to put her time and energy into other dimensions of her personal and parish life. I thank Syd for her long service, hard work, very astute insights and professionalism. I am greatly indebted to her and the other S.A.G. members for their expertise.

+Thanks to **John Peterson and Joel Salazar of our St. Peter's Boy Scouts of America organizations** who spoke at masses last weekend **celebrating Scouting Sunday**. Here at St. Peter's the scouting community has been blessed to have a relationship that spans over two decades of serving the community of Boerne. Boy Scout Troop 18 was the first organization established for middle school and high school boys in the community. Cub Scout Pack 18 was established later to accommodate the elementary boys interested in scouting. In the last decade, Venture Crew 18 for young men and women between the ages of 14 through 21 was established. Recent changes in BSA Scouting in the last couple of years have given our community two opportunities for young women to become involved in the Boy Scouts of America. Cub Scouting has opened the doors to elementary age girls and almost one year ago St. Peter's helped establish Boy Scout Troop 180 for girls.

The past and present scout leadership, combined with the support of St. Peter's Parish, has already impacted thousands of youth in Boerne and surrounding communities. The current and future leadership will have an opportunity to impact even more children in this growing community as we fulfill the mission of the Boy Scouts of America. Their mission is to prepare young people to be good citizens and members of faith communities, and to make ethical and moral choices over their lifetime by instilling them with the

TESTIMONIAL

Several years ago, my whole world suddenly collapsed. One moment I was relatively content, and the next I was assaulted on every front by lifechanging events that profoundly affected my family, marriage, health, finances, and even my spiritual life. I began a journey of suffering that seemed endless. I was filled with an overwhelming sense of powerlessness. Because I had so little control over the outcome of these events, I was overcome with

fear and grief. I reached out to the Stephen Ministry and discovered it was a godsend. My Stephen Minister listened without trying to solve my problems. LIVE THE LITURGY

One of the greatest and most necessary gifts God gives us is free will. We always have the ability to choose. Life or death and good or evil are two of the core decisions every human being must make. We can choose to love and choose whether to pursue a relationship with God. True salvation comes when we make the choices that keep us focused on God and God's commandments. How we view others reveals what choices we have made. People are not property, and they are not dispensable. We cannot exchange them at will or use them for our own self-serving ends. For this reason, God holds high the commitment of marriage and the integrity of all of our relationships. This is the basis of God's teaching on forgiveness and reconciliation, and the reason adultery is prohibited.
