

From the
Pastor's Desk

*Please be aware that due to the national holiday, **Memorial Day**, our bulletin publisher requires very early submission of content for the holiday edition as well as the weekend before and after it. That means our staff has to prepare in advance to include the necessary information for that week. It also means that some of the information will be dated by the time it is printed and distributed at weekend services. We apologize for this, but there is little we can do about it. Know that we are trying our best!



*The **massacre at Robb Elementary School in Uvalde Texas** is shocking, and heartbreaking to us all. This shooting is another in a growing trend in modern society and difficult to comprehend. The killing innocent children and teachers while they are learning and preparing for their life's future is unfathomable. These mass shootings cause trauma, life-long pain, loss, grief and suffering for family members and the larger community. Having this happen in Uvalde is "close to home" — so close that this small town is a part of our Archdiocese of San Antonio. My heart goes out to the families, all who responded to the crisis, the pastor of the parish, Fr. Eddie Morales, Sacred Heart Parish, and their parishioners.

We are waiting to hear more from Archbishop Gustavo about what he may request from all parishes and missions of the Archdiocese. Surely

the Archbishop encourages us to spiritually support the families, but he may, for example, call for a Second Collection to assist the families with multiple needs. Many of us want to help but are not sure how is the best way to do it. We can feel helpless in our honest desire to share our compassion, help and concern. I have been told that there is an overwhelming outpouring of compassion and offers to help in every way possible from around the world. The best thing we can do at this time is pray for the families to make it through this horrible situation. Prayer is powerful when we do it sincerely and often.

Archbishop Gustavo and his Auxiliary Bishops are in Uvalde providing spiritual presence, consolation, help and hope. Catholic Charities of the Archdiocese of San Antonio is providing crisis relief services to those affected by the tragedy. Counselors and case managers are providing therapy and care to those traumatized by the shooting. Catholic Charities is on-site assessing the needs of the community to provide love and care, financial assistance, and support to children, families, and friends. Catholic Charities is also providing emergency financial assistance for family members who need to travel to Uvalde. All services provided to those affected are free. The Department of Catholic Schools also sent staff and counselors to Uvalde to assist those in need of these services. The Archdiocese of San Antonio Catholic Cemeteries System is offering free cremations for those families who choose this. These are some of the ways the Archdiocese is providing much needed assistance to the people of Uvalde. We will keep you posted about future Archdiocesan outreach developments.

*Archbishop Gustavo Garcia-Siller delivered the following statement, "Archbishop's Statement regarding Uvalde School Shooting:"

There are no words to adequately convey the deep sadness and sorrow and overwhelming shock at the incomprehensible loss of life of 19 children and two adults at Robb Elementary School in Uvalde Tuesday afternoon at the hands of a young gunman. When will these insane acts of violence end; it is too great a burden to bear. The word tragedy doesn't begin to describe what

occurred. These massacres cannot be considered "the new normal." The Catholic Church consistently calls for the protection of all life; and these mass shootings are a most pressing life issue on which all in society must act — elected leaders and citizens alike. We pray that God comfort and offer compassion to the families of these little ones whose pain is unbearable. They must know that we are with them and for them. May the Lord have mercy on us all. From the Book of Wisdom, "The souls of the just are in the hands of God... They are in peace."

*Thank you to everyone who spearheaded and organized the special **Adoration to pray for those in Uvalde** after the horrible tragedy. Thank you also to all who participated. Adoration was followed by Adam Olmos' Prayer and Worship concert, which began with a prayer for the victims of the Uvalde shooting, their families and friends, and the community. We are considering putting on a special prayer service next week. Information about a service will be communicated via Flocknote.

***We congratulate Adam Olmos, our Liturgy & Music Director**, for his **Praise & Worship Concert** held on Wednesday, May 26th, in the Sanctuary. There was very good attendance and support from our community, his family and friends. People said the concert was "just what was needed" in light of the tragic news about the Uvalde School shooting. Music and song are very spiritual and therapeutic for all of us. Thanks Adam for sharing your personal and original creations of music and songs. Blessings on the growth of your talents and gifts and for sharing them with our faith community.

*Adam Olmos also arranged for the **Archdiocese of San Antonio Young Adults Choir** to play and sing for our 11:00 am Mass today, June 5th. Adam not only accepted their offer to enhance our worship, but practiced with them in preparation. This is a wonderful gift to our community from the youth from throughout the Archdiocese.

*As one of the many **planned events for this summer for our children and youth**, we presented the first **"Movie Night"** on the church lawn on Thursday, May 16th. The evening started with ice cream treats at 8:30 pm and then as dark set in at 9:00 pm, the movie began on a big, easy-to-see

screen. We will be announcing future summer events and hope both children/youth and parents participate. We are trying to enhance our outreach and engagement of this quickly growing sector of our faith-community.

*We hope that everyone had a great **Memorial Day Holiday** and that you celebrated in the spirit that it was created — those who have served our country and given their lives. I also hope that everyone was able to rest and relax a bit before returning to your very busy family schedules.

*Several **new ministries and services** are in the process of development for our parish: A **mentoring program** with Hill Country Daily Bread led by Mary & Wayne Strapper, **"That Man is You,"** a ministry outreach for the men of the community, led by Marco Nuñez, and **Habitat for Humanity**. If you are interested in any of these ministries/services, please call Deacon Brad or Fr. Norman.

*Congratulations to **Elizabeth Beaton**, daughter of Steve & Diane Beaton, and **Nicholas Seastrunk**, son of Brian & Katherine Seastrunk, who were married here at St. Peter's Parish on Saturday, June 4th, at 3:00 pm with Fr. Norman as celebrant and witness to their vows. Blessings for a long and wonderful marriage!


Welcome!







He is an ATAP Certified Threat Manager with more than 16 years' experience in mental health, violence risk assessment, and threat assessment. 

