

The Catholic Church has never wavered on the teaching that abortion is a moral sin and that we should respect and protect life from natural conception to natural death. Catholics and other Christians have consistently prayed and marched for the right to life of the unborn. Our Knights of Columbus have generously provided aid and state of the art ultrasound machines. Additionally, we are having more and more parishioners/leaders wanting to make pulpit announcements at weekend Masses. We have gotten to the point where we are having too many pulpit announcements and some speakers do not follow the format requested and the limited time frame allotted. Also, some people walk into the sacristy five minutes before Masses wanting something announced. As a result, going forward, we will restrict pulpit announcements to the bare minimum, as determined by Fr. Norman and Parish Staff. One of the deacons or Fr. Norman will make the majority of announcements from **now on**. All ministries, services and organizations must be proactive and plan ahead to properly announce their events and invite parishioners to participate.
