

Judith will perform a **Christmas Organ Recital**, in the Sanctuary, on Thursday, December 15th from 12:00 pm to 1:00 pm. Thank you, Judith for sharing your wonderful talent with us.

## EDGE OLIFE TEEN

## Reflection Questions on St. Peter's EDGE & Life Teen Ministries

On Monday, November 28th, Fr. Norman and Mary Ann Matteson, with assistance from Lacey Sorrell, hosted a meeting with 20+ leaders, volunteers and parents of youth in our EDGE and Life Teen programs to discuss the present state of our youth programs and ministries and what might be done to improve and re-envision them with highly qualified new staff members. The questions below were presented and addressed in the two-hour meeting. The answers and discussion will be summarized into a working document, and a follow-up meeting will be set in a few weeks to distill and agree upon attainable "action items." An action plan will be created, using these action items, and will be used going forward to improve our youth programs. If these questions tap the interest of anyone else in the parish, adult or youth, you can send your input to Mary Ann Matteson at maryann@stpetersboerne.com or call (830) 816-5662.

We want the parish to know that we are deliberating these important considerations to improve our outreach to, welcome of, and interest in the youth of our parish who are the next generations of our citizens and country, and, more importantly, the next generation of Catholic faithful, families, and leaders. We will keep you posted on future deliberations and developments in this planning process.

- 1. When St. Peter's Parish staff and volunteers are at their best with Edge/ Life Teen ministry, what is it that we do best (describe the leadership style, content, approach, focus, etc.)?
- 2. In what ways has our Edge/Life Teen ministries been lacking? What is it that we need to do better? What could be changed to increase our enrollment?
- 3. What are the greatest challenges that youth in Boerne and the surrounding Hill Country area are facing and coping with?
- 4. What are the greatest challenges that parents are facing with their children who are age appropriate to our Edge/Life Teen programs?
- 5. Are you aware of our neighboring parishes (St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, St. Francis of Assisi, and St. Joseph's in Honey Creek) and what they are doing effectively in their EDGE & Life Teen programs? What can we learn from them?
- 6. What "best practices" are you aware of in other churches/denominations that make their youth programs attractive and successful? Would any of these practices be appropriate in a Catholic context (consistent with our theology and spirituality)?
- 7. What level of importance and role do you think each of these topics should play in a successful youth program?"
  - \* Family-oriented focus
  - \* Entertainment of youth
  - \* Music/song including youth concerts
  - \* Missionary work
  - Evangelization of other youth
  - \* Other? Please provide details.
- 8. How can we solicit more parental participation in our youth programs? What type of involvements would attract them in connecting with their teens?
- 9. What uniquely does the Catholic faith and Church have to offer youth as they grow and develop into the next generation of citizens and civic and church leaders?
- 10. Any suggestions on how to navigate through the rest of this year as we rely on volunteers to lead our programs?



The Stewardship Council has met monthly for a number of years with the objective to support the pastor and parish in promoting stewardship as a way of life regarding the gifts of time, talent, and treasure. The council makes recommendations to the Pastor on parish operations and the allocation of the Parish offertory, and other parish resources with respect to implementing parish goals and objectives. To further these goals and improve parish governance, the Council has been working on establishing the following committees: **Evangelization Committee**; **Vocations Committee**; **Parish Facility Committee** and **Development Committee** (i.e., wills, bequeathments, etc.) and on an "as needed" basis, a **Capital Campaign Committee**, and **Increased Offertory Committee**.



An example of recent efforts, **the Facility Committee** has been formed and has met to begin the process of developing St Peter's Campus Development Plan. The plan would involve short term projects (present to 2 years); MidTerm Projects (2-4 years), and Long-Range projects (5-10 years). The committee will review and help scope facility requirements (major maintenance & repair as well as capital projects) as well as develop a budget and plans for execution. The committee will be supported by members of the parish, the parish staff, and key ministries (on an "as needed basis"), such as youth directors, Good Shepard, faith formation, etc. The Committee will provide recommendations to the Stewardship Council as well as the Pastor. Updates will be provided to the Parish as this new committee continues its work.




#### **Gospel Meditation**

Life can leave us feeling dark and desolate. Sandy was just twenty-eight when her husband, Rob, died, leaving her to raise their two young children. She was without paid employment. Rob went to work one morning and never returned home. Sandy, though, had faith and trusted that somehow God would help her through, even though most days brought deafening, piercing loneliness. She persevered, and the darkness gave way to light. Remarking one day to a friend hesitant to commit to a relationship, Sandy shared her wisdom. Even if she knew the outcome would be the same, she would marry Rob again. She assured her friend that she would even do this if eight years could only be eight minutes. We are being led by God and God transforms the darkness into light.

"Be strong, fear not!" Those are easy words to say. Putting them into practice is the challenge. When our paths are dark and life's roads become treacherous, we can easily complain about life's unfinished nature. When will the pain go away? Will the loneliness ever cease? Will I experience happiness again? As the farmer needs to exercise patience with the soil, we need to do the same with our lives. We have to wait for the early and late rains to come, properly tend to our gardens, and ensure that the rich nutrients of God's merciful and tender presence continue to enrich us. God is not done. God has only just begun his work in us.

We cannot allow life to hold us captive. The systems, agendas, protocols, regulations, expectations, and unfinished business can distract us from what it means to be God's child. Life can leave us feeling cheated, negative, and parched. All times and seasons of our spiritual and liturgical lives lead us to three virtues: faith, hope and love. Stop complaining about what is wrong and look to what God can make right! Joy that flows from the Baptist's message: in Jesus, the one mightier than he, are found healing, reconciliation, and freedom. Christ will save us from life's distortions, illusions, and disappointments. Do you believe this?



## END OF YEAR AND CHRISTMAS GIVING

At this time of year many families are reviewing their financial situations and making decisions for charitable giving in light of possible tax advantages. A statistic published recently states that for many nonprofit organizations, including churches, up to one-third of their yearly income for budgeting comes from charitable donations given between November and December. St. Peter's Parish experiences a significant amount of its yearly income donated at this time of year as well, through the incredible generosity of our membership.

St. Peter the Apostle Catholic Church is a missiondriven parish following the Gospel of Jesus Christ. We share in a very transparent way how your generous contributions are used responsibly, fulfilling that mission while also preparing for our future growth. Our bulletin is a major vehicle of direct communication with the parish about the specific ways in which our organizations, ministries and services reach deep into the parish and larger Boerne community, serving people's needs in light of Bible

teaching.
Catholic parishioner
donations are made in light
of the fact that, in the
Christian Tradition, we
believe that everything we

have is a blessing and gift from God. Our charitable giving throughout the year is instructed by the biblicallybased, long-held tenets of Stewardship - giving of Time, Talent and Treasurer.

We are now celebrating Advent and Christmas, marking the preparation for and celebration of the greatest gift in history - God's gift of His only Son, Jesus Christ, our Lord and Redeemer. The story of the Three Kings or wise men seeking and finding the Christ-Child is the backdrop of the tradition of gift-bearing and giving at this time of the year. As stewards of God's abundant blessings and gifts to us throughout this year, let all our families consider and pre-plan for how you may include St. Peter's Parish in your charitable giving before vear's end.

Your donations can be made to our parish general fund, our newly established St. Peter Endowment Fund or specifically to an organization or ministry of the parish. You should designate your intentions at the time of your donation. Below we have reprinted the "Methods of Giving" pages we developed for uses in parish life. We trust it will be helpful in summarizing possible ways of giving from your resources. Thank you!

#### **METHODS OF GIVING**

Selecting the best way of giving for you depends on your personal financial situation and goals. As tax laws are always changing, and each individual's financial situation is different, donors are encouraged to consult a professional advisor (See "Note 1"). Consider the following suggested ways of donating:

#### WHAT YOU CAN DONATE

You can donate cash, check, money order or electronic money transfer in any amount and increment you decide. You may also make payments using credit cards, automatic withdrawal through online banking from your checking or savings account or through our online platform, *WeGather* (see "How to Donate).

You can donate stocks, bonds, mutual funds, EFTs, CDs, gold, free-and-clear owned real estate, art, life insurance policies, etc.

Real Estate. Current tax law allows donors of real property, which have been held for at least 12 months, to take an income tax deduction equal to the full market value with no capital gains tax.



Life Insurance. You may donate to the campaign by making St. Peter the Apostle Catholic Church owner and beneficiary of your fully paid policy. The parish office will assist you with the correct wording.

**Corporate Matching Gifts.** 

A matching gift program provided through your employer or board membership may allow you to increase the value of your gift. Many companies match charitable gifts of their employees, retirees or board members. Consult your employer's human resources director or community outreach director to see if your company has a matching gift program.

Family Foundations and Community Funds. While we conduct research to discover foundations whose mission aligns with St. Peter's projects, there are many family foundations not listed in publications, especially those managed by a community fund. If you have a family foundation or contribute to a donor-advised community fund and you



would like to invest in the future of St. Peter's and the archdiocese, please contact Marilyn Belcher or Debra Martini at (830) 816-2233.

Donor Advised Funds (charitable accounts), once legally set-up and active, allow holders to receive deductions for donations immediately while spreading payments over the next several years. Grants from these funds can be made to qualified charities, such as

your parish.

**Required Minimum** Distributions from Retirement Accounts. If you are at the age 72, when you must make a required minimum distribution (RMD) from your retirement account, that distribution is usually taxable at your ordinary income tax rate. However, by making a qualified charitable contribution directly from your retirement account to St. Peter's, you can fulfill your RMD requirement without paying any taxes on it. The parish office can provide more information about this method of fulfilling your pledge.

Qualified Charitable
Distribution (QCD), also
called charitable IRA rollover.
The requirements for QCDs
are summarized at https://
www.irs.gov/retirementplans/retirement-plans-faqsregarding-iras-distributionswithdrawals:

- Donor must be 70<sup>1/2</sup> or older.
- QCD is limited to \$100,000 per taxpayer per year.

- Donation must be from a traditional IRA (not SEP, SIMPLE, or beneficiary IRA).
- Donor-advised funds are not eligible to receive QCDs.
- Direct your IRA trustee to send funds directly to a 501 (c)(3) charitable organization (churches qualify). The charity you donate to will not have to pay taxes on your donation, maximizing the benefit of your charitable contribution.
- Distributions will be reported as "Normal Distribution" on your IRS Form 1099-R. You will need to keep track of your donations in order to exclude them from income.
- Follow instructions for QCD on line 15 of your IRS Form 1040, or notify your tax preparer.
- If you itemize deductions, remember that you cannot deduct the charitable contribution if you have already excluded it from income. You are allowed just one tax break, not two.

Note 1: There are many types of qualified accounts including 401(k), 403(b), 457 plans and others in addition to IRAs, and they are all subject to the Required Minimum Distribution (RMD). However, under current rules, you can only do the QCD from a traditional IRA. If you want to apply this strategy to another type of qualified account, such as a 401(k) or a 403(b), you would need to roll that account over into an IRA.

You would want to discuss such a move with your financial advisor or tax professional.

Note 2: You can also use your QCD to meet all or part of your IRA's Required Minimum Distribution (RMD). This RMD is usually taxable at your ordinary income tax rate. However, by making a qualified charitable contribution directly from your retirement account to St. Peter's, you can fulfill your RMD requirement without paying any taxes on it. Traditional IRA owners must start taking RMDs at age  $70^{1/2}$  or face tax penalties. The charity must receive your donation by December 31st for you to apply it to that year's tax return. Roth IRAs do not require distributions while the account holder is alive. It has been said that the QCD/RMD is one of the best remaining tax reduction incentives and means of charitable contributions one can make today.

Tip: With the 202 tax law changes, there's 1 additional factor to consider: you may take advantage of the higher standard deduction (\$12,400 for single filers, \$24,800 if married and filing jointly). This means that if you claim the standard deduction, you won't be allowed to itemize things like charitable donations. However since QCDs are not includable in income the QCD is also not deductible. As such, the QCD can remain an option for your charitable giving, even if you

claim the standard deduction in a given year.

Donate through your Last Will and overall Estate Plan. Such gifts are a lasting memorial and expand our parish's ability to continue its growth and be a strong Catholic presence in Boerne and surrounding Texas Hill Country.

#### **HOW TO DONATE**

We strongly encourage online electronic giving through WeGather, used in our parish for your convenience. Go to our parish website and click on "Give Now" at the top right of the screen and follow instructions. It allows you to donate using specific approved credit cards. Call Marilyn Belcher, our Finance Manager, if you have any specific questions or difficulties in setting up a donor account.

**Disclosure 1**: Any of the foregoing type donations should be executed only with

the professional consultation and specific advice of your banker, broker, financial/investment advisor, accountant, tax professional, tax attorney, etc. There can be significant tax advantages to your donations, but all IRS laws must be followed for such purposes with full professional advice.

Disclosure 2: St. Peter's Parish has a brokerage account with Frost Bank to facilitate direct transfer of publicly traded securities (without your selling them) to meet IRS rules and for maximum tax benefit. After professional advice, you must instruct your financial/ investment advisor/IRA trustee to transfer any assets you wish to donate. It cannot be done by our parish staff on your behalf. Please contact Marilyn Belcher, our Finance Manager, at (830) 816-2233 to receive instructions on how to transfer such donations to our parish through the Frost Bank account.



### ENDOWMENT FUND

Another Recommended Focus for End-Year and Christmas Giving

Our Senior Advisory Group (SAG), now called the Stewardship Council. continues to work on reenvisioning parish governance, overseeing our Stewardship Giving, and other aspects of charitable giving in the parish. The Council has been discussing two important things: 1.) The wisdom of establishing a long -term investment for future normal and emergency maintenance of the parish campus as it grows, develops, ages, (not for capital improvement projects), and 2.) how to encourage parishioners to remember the parish in their general donations but specifically in their Last Wills, Estate Plans and Bequests by establishing an endowment fund for the parish.

A couple of the parish who wish to remain anonymous donated \$5,000 of "seed money" and on August 28, 2020 established the "St. Peter the Apostle Catholic **Church Endowment Fund"** with the Catholic **Community Foundation** (CCF). The CCF was established by Archbishop Gomez many years ago for Archdiocesan parishes, organizations and agencies to pool their investments under professional financial management. Our present Archbishop Gustavo hopes that every parish of the

Archdiocese sets up an endowment fund for specific parish purposes. As an incentive for parishes to set-up an endowment with a \$5K deposit, the CCF adds another \$2,500 to the account. That means we started the Endowment with an automatic \$7,500.00 deposit, thanks to the generosity and vision of this anonymous couple.

The Endowment Fund Agreement states the Purposes of the Fund in the following way: "The purpose of the St. Peter the Apostle Catholic Church Endowment Fund is specifically limited to providing annual distributions to St. Peter the Apostle Catholic Church currently located at 202 W. Kronkosky, Boerne, TX 78006, with said distributions only (1) to be used for the purposes of St. Peter the Apostle Catholic Church Parish, its operations, buildings, grounds, ministries, schools and programs as directed by the pastor; or (2) to be donated by St. Peter the Apostle Catholic Church to the Catholic Community Foundation for the Roman Catholic Church of the Archdiocese of San Antonio to be returned to the corpus of the St. Peter the Apostle Catholic Church Endowment Fund." We thank Deacon John Benage, the Vice President of Planned & Estate Gifts of the CCF, for helping establish this Endowment.

Our Stewardship Council will be further discussing this Endowment Fund and developing an information sharing ("marketing") plan for

it. Announcements will be made later regarding the results of their deliberations. This anonymous gift to the parish will be a blessing for generations to come. The donor couple are an inspiration for other parishioners to be as generous. This Endowment will assure further financial stability as our parish grows with age and grace, meeting the needs of Catholics in Boerne and the Texas Hill Country. We assure you that this Endowment is not and will not become another capital campaign. It will be advertised and made available as a means of parishioners giving donations toward it while alive or at the time of their death. Should you be interested in donating toward this Endowment Fund, please call either Fr. Norman, Deacon Brad Wakely, our Parish Operations Director, or Marilyn Belcher, our Finance Manager. Again, thanks to the donors!
