***November 1 & 2, All Saints & All Souls Day** are spiritually significant in our church liturgical calendar and pastoral practice. **All Saints Day** helps us focus on the universal call to holiness for everyone and honoring those formally declared and informally known saints in our lives.

All Souls Day helps us accept the reality of death as a part of Christian life. It also helps us remember and honor all those who have died before us. These two days are invitations to remember, pray with and for all of our deceased loved ones and friends. Visiting cemeteries, cleaning graves, decorating them, and conversing with and praying for them is common pastoral practice.

Remember our **Mass of Remembrance** tomorrow night, Monday, at 6:30pm. Please join us!

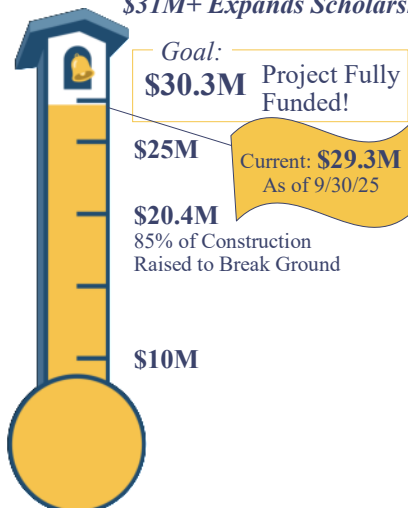

«SI MUERO CON CRISTO, VIVIRÉ CON ÉL» (cf. Rom 6,8)

por José Luis (Pepe) Romero

Este pasaje enfatiza la conexión entre la muerte y la resurrección de Cristo y la vida del creyente. En el Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica (CIC) 1005, se afirma que "la muerte es la consecuencia del pecado". Sin embargo, a través de la muerte y resurrección de Cristo, los creyentes son llamados a una nueva vida. La celebración del Bautismo encarna esta realidad, donde el creyente es sumergido en el agua, simbolizando la muerte al pecado, y resucita a una nueva vida en Cristo, como se menciona en Romanos 6,4: **"Fuimos, pues, con él sepultados por el bautismo en la muerte, a fin de que, al igual que Cristo fue resucitado de entre los muertos por medio de la gloria del Padre, así también nosotros vivamos una vida nueva"**.

Doctrinalmente, el pasaje nos recuerda que la vida cristiana está marcada por la identificación con Cristo. La doctrina de la participación en la muerte y resurrección de Cristo es fundamental para entender la salvación. En Gálatas 2,20, San Pablo expresa esta realidad: **"Con Cristo estoy crucificado; y ya no vivo yo, sino que Cristo vive en mí"**. Esto ilustra que el proceso de la salvación no es solo un acto histórico, sino también una experiencia viva que transforma al creyente. La doctrina de la resurrección se convierte así en la esperanza fundamental del cristiano, como señala el CIC 994: "La resurrección de todos los muertos es el mismo corazón de la fe cristiana".

Teológicamente, la frase "estamos seguros de que también viviremos con él" nos invita a reflexionar sobre la esperanza de la vida eterna. La resurrección de Cristo es la garantía de la resurrección de los creyentes. En 1 Corintios 15,20-22, se nos dice: **"¡Pero no! Cristo resucitó de entre los muertos como primicia de los que murieron. Porque habiendo venido por un hombre la muerte, también por un hombre viene la resurrección de los muertos"**. Pues del mismo modo que por Adán mueren todos, así también todos revivirán en Cristo. Esta promesa de vida eterna es un pilar central de la fe cristiana y nos motiva a vivir de acuerdo con los del Reino de Dios aquí y ahora.

En concreto, el pasaje nos confronta con la realidad de nuestra propia vida y muerte. En un mundo donde la muerte a menudo se percibe con temor, la fe cristiana ofrece una perspectiva de esperanza y transformación. La vida en Cristo implica un compromiso constante con el crecimiento espiritual y la lucha contra el pecado. En Filipenses 3,20-21, San Pablo nos recuerda: **"Pero nosotros somos ciudadanos del cielo, de donde esperamos como Salvador al Señor Jesucristo, el cual transfigurará este miserable cuerpo nuestro en un cuerpo glorioso como el suyo"**. Este recordatorio de nuestra verdadera identidad y destino nos impulsa a vivir con propósito y esperanza.

En conclusión, el pasaje "si hemos muerto con Cristo, estamos seguros de que también viviremos con él" encapsula la esencia de la vida cristiana: la identificación con la muerte y resurrección de Cristo, la esperanza de la vida eterna y la llamada a vivir en novedad de vida. Nos invita a reconocer que, mediante la fe, hemos sido transformados y que nuestra vida en Cristo es una participación activa en su misterio pascual. Al vivir con esta certeza, podemos enfrentar la vida y la muerte con la confianza de que, al final, la victoria de Cristo sobre la muerte se convierte en nuestra victoria. Como dice Romanos 8,37: **"Pero en todo esto salimos vencedores gracias a aquel que nos amó"**. Esta es la promesa que nos sostiene y nos guía en nuestro caminar diario.
