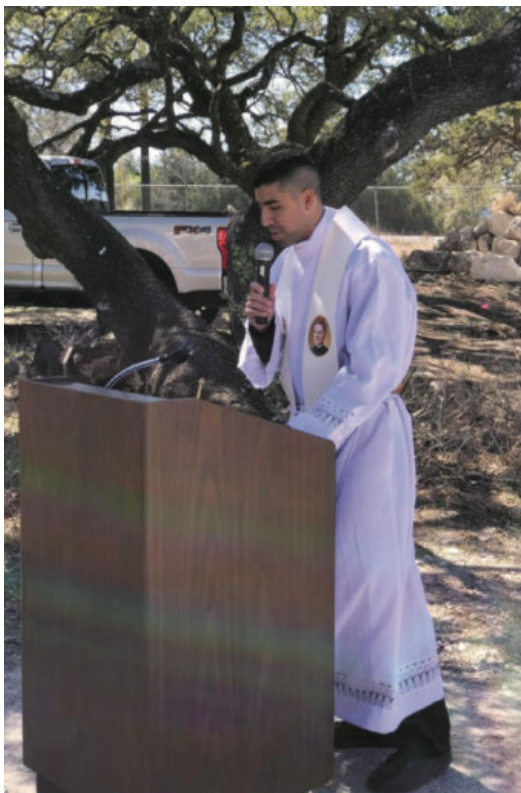

Thank you to everyone who coordinated these events to offer our parishioners.

*As our school construction ramps up, **parking for construction employees will be sectioned off in our upper parking lot during the work day Monday through Friday**. This is to minimize traffic congestion at the construction entrances and on Hosack Street. Parking will reopen at the end of each day and be open on the weekends. Please refer to the map on the right. In addition, starting Monday, 3/17, construction on and around the church entrance on Hosack will begin. During this period of construction, it is best to avoid Hosack except for local traffic. Thank you for your understanding and patience.

*We are working double-time on making sure we are ready to go for the inaugural school year at **St. Peter the Apostle Catholic School**. 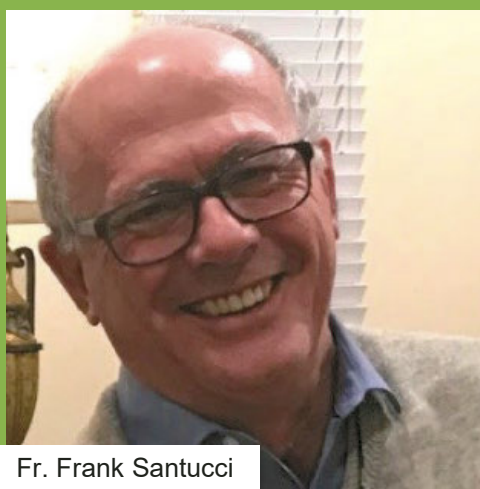

La pregunta de Jesús "¿Me amas?" es un llamado profundo que resuena a lo largo de los siglos, invitándonos a reflexionar sobre nuestra relación personal con Él. Este cuestionamiento, que aparece de manera conmovedora en el Evangelio de Juan (21,15-17), se presenta en un contexto donde Jesús, después de su resurrección, busca reafirmar la conexión con sus discípulos, especialmente con Pedro. Esta interacción no solo es un momento crucial para Pedro, quien había negado a Jesús tres veces, sino que también es un espejo en el que cada uno de nosotros puede mirarse.

Cuando Jesús nos pregunta "¿Me amas?", nos confronta con la realidad de nuestra fe. Este amor no es simplemente un sentimiento; es una decisión que implica acción. En la respuesta de Pedro, "Sí, Señor, tú sabes que te amo", se manifiesta la necesidad de una respuesta sincera y comprometida. Jesús responde a esta afirmación con un mandato: "Apacienta mis ovejas". Este intercambio revela que el amor hacia Cristo se traduce en el cuidado y el servicio a los demás. Nos desafía a una conversión continua, a despojarnos de lo que nos aleja de Él y a buscar una relación más profunda y auténtica.

El amor de Jesús es incondicional y siempre está presente, independientemente de nuestras fallas y debilidades. Al responder a su pregunta, también reconocemos la magnitud de su amor por nosotros. Su sacrificio en la cruz es la expresión máxima de ese amor, y al aceptar su invitación, nos estamos entregando a una relación transformadora. El amor que Jesús nos ofrece nos llama a responder con gratitud y a vivir de manera que refleje ese amor en nuestra vida cotidiana.

En conclusión, la pregunta "¿Me amas?" es un llamado a la introspección y a la acción. Nos invita a profundizar en nuestra fe, a vivir un amor que se manifiesta en el servicio y a renovar nuestro compromiso con Cristo y con los demás.
