Doug and Barbara Vogt are true servants at St. Peter's and have been for many years.

Doug and Barbara have lived their faith by serving in many ministerial capacities over the years. Barbara has served as an amazing Catholic Daughters Member and Regent. Although retired from the position, she maintains a key role in CDA, reporting activities for State and National Awards. Under her leadership CDA has won multiple state and national awards. Among her many other achievements, she led CDA's collaboration with Elementary Faith Formation for a yearly diaper drive for Hill Country Pregnancy Care Center. Since retiring from her CDA leadership role, she has not stopped serving the organization.

Barbara has worked tirelessly with nursing homes for years. As a result of that experience, she founded the "Angel Gift Basket" project at St. Peter's in the early 1990s, which provides Christmas gifts to residents of six nursing facilities and a personal care home (approximately 450 gifts) every Christmas. Doug always provides critical support for this initiative by helping to collect, sort and deliver gifts.

Barbara recently became the Ministry Lead for the Nursing Home Communion Ministry, helping ensure all those within our parish boundaries who are homebound or in nursing homes can receive Holy Communion regularly. Doug and Barbara are also Eucharistic Ministers, work with Hill Country Pregnancy Care Center, attend Bible Studies and have been Faith Formation Catechists. Doug faithfully serves as an usher at Mass each Sunday. Most recently, Barbara was a speaker at our Women of the Decades dinner.

Their contributions to this faith community are sincere and tireless. Doug and Barbara actively live their call to holiness and full participation in the life and mission of the Church, and are genuinely deserving of this recognition given by the Archbishop.

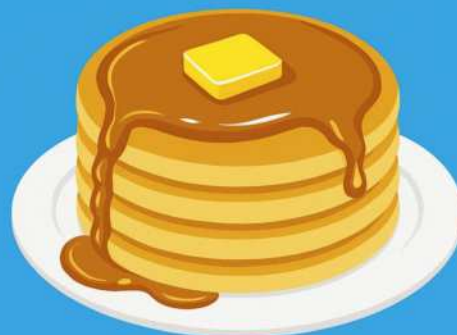

# Children's Ministry

## Elementary Faith Formation

Over the past weeks, the children in the Elementary Faith Formation have been learning the foundations of our Catholic faith and how deeply God loves His people. They began by learning about Adam and Eve and how sin entered the world through disobedience. At the same time, they discovered an important truth: God never stopped loving us. Instead, He sent His Son, Jesus, to be our Savior. Through Jesus' sacrifice, the children learned that all people are offered forgiveness, hope, and new life with God.

The children have also been introduced to the Seven Sacraments, which they learned are special signs Jesus gave to His Church. They understand that the Sacraments show us that Jesus is still with us today, sharing His life and love. Through simple words and actions we can see, God gives us grace that we cannot see but can feel working in our lives.

A special focus has been placed on Baptism, where the children learned that we are welcomed into God's family and made members of the Church. They can now explain how water is poured and the words are spoken in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. They also learned the meaning of the baptismal symbols: the anointing with oil, the white garment, and the light of Christ, all reminding us that we are called to live as children of God.

The children have also been introduced to the other Sacraments: Confirmation, where we are strengthened by the Holy Spirit; the Eucharist, where Jesus gives Himself to us as spiritual food; Reconciliation, where God's forgiveness heals us; Anointing of the Sick, which brings comfort and peace; Holy Orders, through which priests serve the Church; and Matrimony, where couples share God's love through lifelong commitment.

As a parish community, we are invited to reflect on these lessons alongside our children. May their growing understanding of faith inspire us to renew our appreciation for the Sacraments and the grace God continues to offer each of us every day.

## MINISTERIO HISPANO



### El Cordero de Dios

por José Luis (Pepe) Romero

La expresión "Éste es el Cordero de Dios, el que quita el pecado del mundo" es una de las proclamaciones más significativas de la liturgia de la Iglesia Católica. Esta frase, pronunciada por Juan el Bautista en el Evangelio de Juan (1,29), encapsula el misterio de la redención y la misión de Jesucristo. La profundización en este versículo revela aspectos teológicos y espirituales fundamentales para la comprensión de la fe católica.

#### El Cordero de Dios: Un Título Revelador

El título de "Cordero de Dios" tiene raíces profundas en la tradición judía. En el Antiguo Testamento, el cordero era un símbolo de sacrificio y expiación. Durante la Pascua, los israelitas sacrificaban un cordero como parte de la celebración de su liberación de la esclavitud en Egipto (Éxodo 12). Este sacrificio se convertía en un acto de fe y de esperanza en la salvación. Al referirse a Jesús como el "Cordero de Dios", Juan el Bautista nos invita a reconocer que Cristo es el cumplimiento de estas antiguas promesas: el verdadero sacrificio que restaurará la relación entre Dios y la humanidad.

#### La Expiación de los Pecados

La afirmación de que el Cordero "quita el pecado del mundo" es central en la teología católica. La Iglesia enseña que, a través de su muerte en la cruz, Jesús asumió sobre sí los pecados de la humanidad, ofreciendo un sacrificio perfecto que reconcilia a los seres humanos con Dios. Este acto de amor y entrega no solo purifica, sino que también invita a los creyentes a reflexionar sobre su propia vida y sus propios pecados. La invitación a la conversión y el arrepentimiento es una parte integral de la experiencia cristiana, recordando que todos estamos llamados a reconocer nuestras fallas y a buscar la misericordia.

#### La Eucaristía: Encuentro con el Cordero

En la liturgia católica, el momento en que el sacerdote pronuncia estas palabras durante la Misa es de gran solemnidad. Antes de la Comunión, se presenta al Cordero de Dios, invitando a los fieles a reconocer su presencia real en la Eucaristía. Este sacramento se convierte en un encuentro íntimo con Cristo, quien se ofrece a sí mismo como alimento espiritual. La Eucaristía no solo es un recordatorio del sacrificio de Cristo, sino también un medio a través del cual los creyentes reciben gracia y fortaleza para vivir una vida acorde con los valores del Evangelio.

#### Un Llamado a la Acción

La proclamación del Cordero de Dios también conlleva una responsabilidad. Los católicos son llamados no solo a recibir la gracia de la redención, sino también a ser instrumentos de paz y reconciliación en el mundo. Esto implica vivir con compasión, perdón y amor hacia los demás, reflejando el sacrificio de Cristo en nuestras acciones diarias. La vida cristiana se convierte, así, en un testimonio del poder transformador del amor de Dios sobre el pecado y el sufrimiento humano.

#### Conclusión

La frase "Éste es el Cordero de Dios, el que quita el pecado del mundo" es un profundo recordatorio de la identidad de Cristo y del propósito de su misión. En la Iglesia Católica, este reconocimiento invita a los creyentes a una vida de fe activa, centrada en la Eucaristía y en el llamado a ser mensajeros de la esperanza y de la reconciliación. Al contemplar el misterio del Cordero, los católicos son desafiados a vivir de manera que su vida refleje el amor redentor de Cristo y lleve la luz de la fe a un mundo que anhela sanación y paz.

## **SCHOOL CAPITAL CAMPAIGN ANNOUNCEMENT & CONGRATULATIONS**

Julie Seguin, the Executive Director of our School Capital Campaign, announced that, over the Christmas/New Year Holidays, we reached and exceeded the campaign's "Transformational Goal" of \$30.4 million made as one-time donations and pledges. Our parishioners have been incredibly supportive, generous and prayerful in making this campaign so successful donating \$9.8 million in a relatively short time. Clarence & Tina Kahlig of the Kahlig Auto Group continue their incredibly generous support, along with so many individuals, businesses and foundations in Boerne, San Antonio, the Archdiocese of San Antonio and Texas.

The vision for the school is coming into full fruition and reality piece by piece in our opening the St. Peter the Apostle Catholic School for its first year in our existing Family Life Center facilities. We have 112 students, Ms. Brintnall, our Principal, and our teaching/administrative staff. The new 68,000 square foot building is under construction with approximately 80 to 100 workers on the job site daily. Construction is scheduled to be completed in mid-July of this year so that our second school year can begin occupying the facility.

Our School's \$1 million "Jim & Lea Perlitz Scholarship Fund" and our School's \$100K Maintenance Fund have been fully funded and invested. We are currently planning for our second Mardi Gras School Gala to be held on February 13th at 6:00 pm in the Cana Ballroom. Our School Board has been established with working sub-committees to professionally guide and oversee the school for excellence and continuing strength and health.

The ultimate success of our campaign will be donors continuing to pay their pledges that are scheduled for fulfillment over monthly, yearly, quarterly or other negotiated time periods leading to 97% to 100% fulfillment of all pledges. That would allow us to save on interest payments and be debt-free in a timely manner. Again, thank you to all of our parishioners, the Kahligs & all other donors who have donated time, talent and treasure to make our new school possible.

Special thanks to Julie Seguin for her excellent professional services on behalf of our community using her knowledge of fundraising and the philanthropic community. We pray for the safety and health of all the workers who are on the construction teams and subcontractors making this new Catholic educational institution possible for our parish and the Archdiocese.

**HEB CARDS**

How do HEB cards work?

We purchase HEB cards from HEB for 5% less than the face value of the card. Our teens sell the cards for face value (\$10, \$25, \$50, or \$100), St. Peter the Apostle Youth Ministry gets the 5%, and you get to purchase groceries or gas for the full amount of the card. This is a win for you because you know you've got to buy groceries, and a win for our youth because we can continue, and hopefully expand, all that we offer for our teens.

If every registered household in our parish purchased \$20 in groceries each week after purchasing HEB cards from our teens, we would earn \$129,600 for our Youth Ministry. Currently, we have maybe 10 registered households regularly purchasing HEB cards, which means we are leaving money on the table, money that could be used to reduce the need for parents to pay as much for retreats and summer camps, and allowing more teens to be able to participate. If everyone participates based on their actual spending at HEB, we could do amazing things to expand what we offer our youth.

Please help our Youth Ministry by bringing check or cash to Mass and purchasing HEB cards weekly. If you forget on the weekend, you may purchase cards in the parish office during the week (regular office hours). We'd really love to run out of cards.
