«Los exhorto, por lo tanto, yo, prisionero por el Señor, a que vivan de una manera digna de la llamada que han recibido: con toda humildad, mansedumbre y paciencia, soportándose unos a otros con amor, esforzándose por mantener la unidad del Espíritu en el vínculo de la paz». (Efesios 4,1-3)

Reflexión sobre la Humildad en la Iglesia Católica

La humildad es una virtud fundamental en la enseñanza de la Iglesia Católica, profundamente arraigada en el mensaje de Jesucristo y en las Escrituras. A lo largo de la historia, la humildad ha sido reconocida como un camino esencial para acercarse a Dios y a los demás, reflejando el carácter de Cristo mismo.

La Humildad en las Escrituras

Desde el Antiguo Testamento, se nos enseña que la humildad es clave para una vida plena. Proverbios 22,4 dice: "La riqueza, el honor y la vida son el fruto de la humildad y del temor del Señor". En el Nuevo Testamento, Jesús se presenta como el modelo supremo de humildad. En Filipenses 2,7-8, se nos recuerda que "se despojó a sí mismo, tomando forma de siervo, hecho semejante a los hombres". Este acto de encarnación y servicio es el pilar de la humildad cristiana: consiste en poner a los demás por delante de uno mismo.

La Humildad como Base de la Comunidad

Dentro de la Iglesia, la humildad también es esencial para la unidad y la colaboración. Los miembros de la comunidad eclesial están llamados a reconocer sus limitaciones y a actuar con sencillez. Esto se refleja en el Sacerdocio, donde los pastores están llamados a servir, no a ser servidos. Durante su pontificado, el Papa Francisco enfatizó repetidamente la importancia de una Iglesia humilde, que no busque el poder ni la riqueza, sino que se comprometa con los más necesitados.

La Humildad en la Práctica

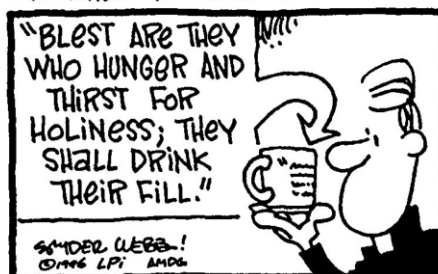
La práctica de la humildad se manifiesta en diversas formas en la vida de la Iglesia. Desde la oración y el servicio a los demás hasta el arrepentimiento y la búsqueda del perdón, los católicos son llamados a vivir esta virtud a diario. Además, la humildad es esencial en la celebración de los sacramentos, donde se reconoce nuestra dependencia de la gracia divina. En la Eucaristía, nos acercamos humildemente al altar, conscientes de nuestra fragilidad y de la grandeza de Dios.

Desafíos Modernos

En un mundo que a menudo valora el éxito y el reconocimiento, la humildad puede parecer contracultural. Sin embargo, la Iglesia Católica invita a sus fieles a resistir estas tentaciones y a encontrar en la humildad una fuente de fortaleza. La humildad no implica una baja autoestima; más bien, es un reconocimiento de nuestra dignidad como hijos de Dios y de nuestra interdependencia con los demás. Esto se convierte en un acto de amor y un testimonio de fe.

La humildad es, por tanto, una virtud que trasciende el tiempo y las circunstancias. En la Iglesia Católica, representa un camino hacia una vida más plena y auténtica, en la que el amor y el servicio son fundamentales. Al seguir el ejemplo de Cristo, los católicos son llamados a vivir en humildad, promoviendo una comunidad donde todos se sientan valorados y amados. La humildad, lejos de ser una debilidad, se convierte en la base sobre la cual se construye una comunidad sólida y unida en la fe.

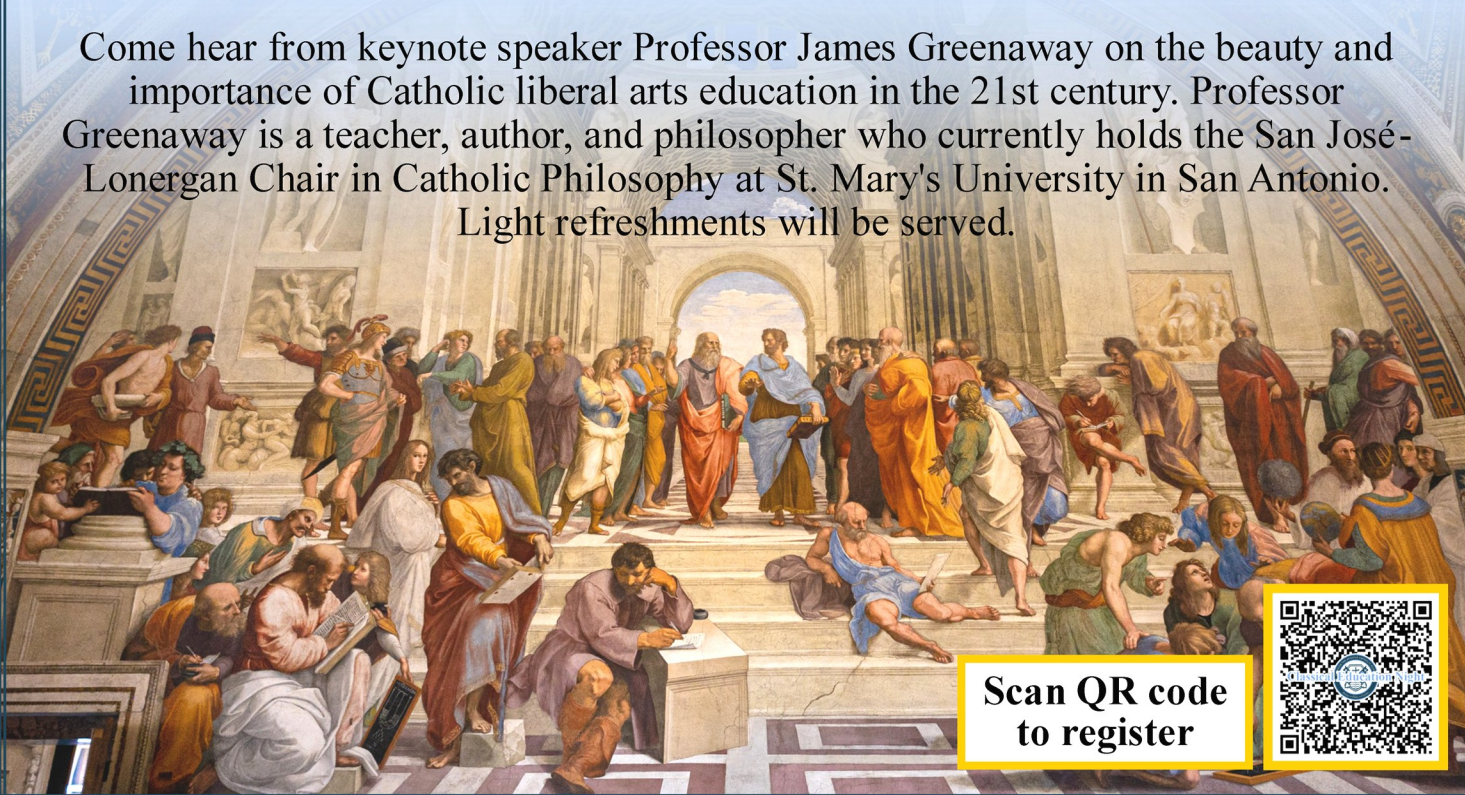

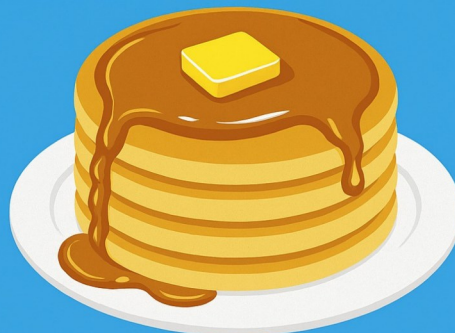

HEB CARDS

How do HEB cards work?

We purchase HEB cards from HEB for 5% less than the face value of the card. Our teens sell the cards for face value (\$10, \$25, \$50, or \$100), St. Peter the Apostle Youth Ministry gets the 5%, and you get to purchase groceries or gas for the full amount of the card. This is a win for you because you know you've got to buy groceries, and a win for our youth because we can continue, and hopefully expand, all that we offer for our teens.

If every registered household in our parish purchased \$20 in groceries each week after purchasing HEB cards from our teens, we would earn \$129,600 for our Youth Ministry. Currently, we have maybe 10 registered households regularly purchasing HEB cards, which means we are leaving money on the table, money that could be used to reduce the need for parents to pay as much for retreats and summer camps, and allowing more teens to be able to participate. If everyone participates based on their actual spending at HEB, we could do amazing things to expand what we offer our youth.

Please help our Youth Ministry by bringing check or cash to Mass and purchasing HEB cards weekly. If you forget on the weekend, you may purchase cards in the parish office during the week (regular office hours). We'd really love to run out of cards.

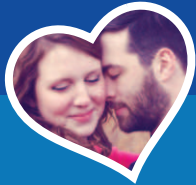

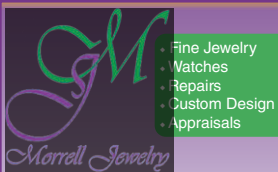
