- Plan on dropping off your chili in a crockpot by 5:45 pm on Friday, October 16th, in the parish hall. You do not need to remain near your dish through the evening, but please pick up your crockpot, ladle, leftover chili by 9 pm. Please bring a ladle with your name on it.

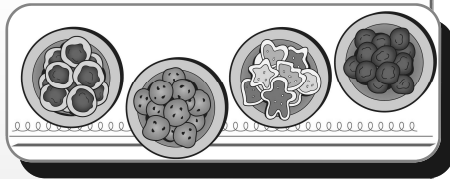
