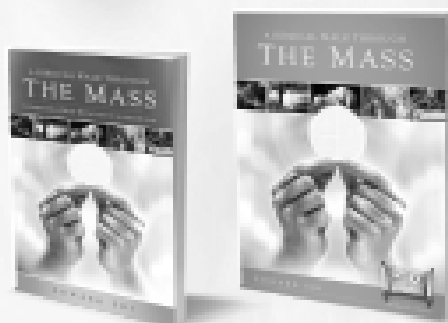

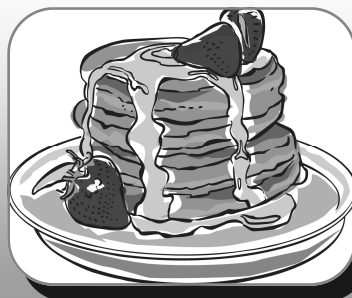

Genesis, Science, and the Church: Assessing Evolution from a Catholic Perspective:

The Book of Genesis discusses God's creation and gives it purpose. The Church has had much to say on this, especially in the Catechism of the Catholic Church. In 1859 when Darwin came out with *The Origin of the Species*, which he himself labelled "the theory of independent acts of creation," it was not immediately accepted. However, it gradually became widely accepted in the scientific community and has evolved in complexity and scope greatly since that time.
