

Everything Old is New Again:

A Lecture on the Subject of facing the same direction during Holy Mass based on Uwe Michael Lang's work, "Turning Towards the Lord."

Tuesday, June 6th at 6:30 P.M. in the Parish Hall

Ever since the liberalization of the Pre-Conciliar liturgical books by Pope Benedict XVI 2007, there has been a renewed interest in our Latin Rite liturgical heritage most especially among younger clergy and lay people alike. Is this simply a nostalgia for a past that we didn't experience? I will argue that it is something far greater than this—it is a recovery of our liturgical identity as Catholics. In this movement, many have returned to the once universal posture of celebrating Mass facing the same direction. This has excited some members of the Church, but also has confused others.

In this lecture, I will discuss in detail the meaning of this posture of prayer, typically called *ad orientem* or towards the East. I will speak in particular about what directional prayer means in both Judaism and Christianity as well as what this has traditionally meant in the context of the celebration of the Eucharist. Lastly, I will highlight Lang's points for how we can more profoundly experience the presence of God at Mass and how this can and should affect our spiritual lives in our journey to meet the Risen Lord. Please join me on **Tuesday, June 6th at 6:30 P.M. in the Parish Hall** for an educational experience where questions and discussion will be welcomed after the presentation. I hope to see you there!



APOLOGETICS CORNER: *This question is a commonly posed one by our Protestant brethren. How would you respond should you be asked?*

Q: Why do Protestants not believe John 6 when it says that Jesus' flesh is real food and that His blood is real drink?

A: I don't know! In **Matthew 26**, **Mark 14**, and **Luke 22**, Jesus says of the bread, "**This is my body.**" He says of the wine, "**This is my blood.**" Not "*this is symbolic of,*" or "*this represents,*" He says "**this IS.**" In **John 6**, He repeats Himself, like He does nowhere else in Scripture, to emphasize the fact that He expects us to eat His flesh and drink His blood and that His flesh is real food and that His blood is real drink.

Anyone who says He is speaking symbolically, simply is refusing to look at all of the facts.

Fact #1: The Jews took him literally, verse 52.

Fact #2: His disciples took him literally, verse 60.

Fact #3, the Apostles took him literally, verses 67-69.

If everyone who heard him speak at the time took Him **literally**, then my question is: Why does anyone today, 2000 years after the fact, take him **symbolically**?

Also, in verse 51, Jesus says that the bread which He will give for the life of the world is His flesh. When did He give His flesh for the life of the world? On the cross. Was that symbolic? If you think Jesus is speaking symbolically here when He says that we must eat His flesh and drink His blood, then you must also conclude that Jesus' death on the cross was symbolic...it wasn't really Jesus hanging up there...it was symbolic flesh and symbolic blood.

Jesus is clearly talking about the flesh that He gave for the life of the world...He did that **on the cross**. Those who believe He is talking symbolically here in **John 6**, have a real problem when it comes to **John 6:51**. Did Jesus give His real flesh and blood for the life of the world, or was it only His symbolic flesh and blood?
