WHAT ARE YOU GIVING UP THIS LENT? Hopefully it benefits others as Fr. Rueb has shared with us. Regardless, may I suggest giving up some time? Maybe time to make extended examination of conscience? An extra time to go to confession – instead of once per month, maybe once every other week? Perhaps shuffling your schedule to make morning Mass during the week, maybe one more time than usual? A few minutes earlier and join in for the rosary. How about an hour with our Lord at adoration – “Can you not watch with me one hour?”

These are just suggestions. I share them because I find it more rewarding than giving up chocolate (at least more fun). Even though there are three sessions left this month, you are certainly welcome to join us Tuesdays for NO GREATER LOVE.

Have a blessed and fruitful Lent. I look forward to celebrating with you the Holy Week (Palms) with Holy Thursday (institution of Eucharist and priesthood), Good Friday (venerating our Lord's own “altar”, the cross), and anticipating the Resurrection on Holy Saturday/Easter Sunday (the fulfillment of the prophecy in Gen. 3:15). Oh, give up some time to read that verse and you cannot help giving thanks for the love God has for us.

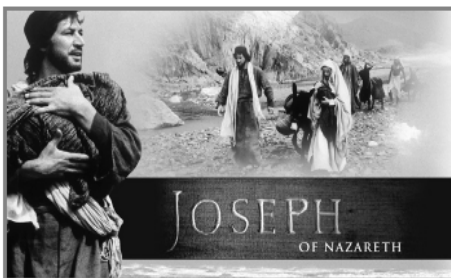


Q: What does it mean to say the Pope is “infallible”?

A: Just as Christ established a visible Church, He also provided a visible person to guide the Church—the pope. Because the pope is guiding and teaching the Church in Christ's name, His teachings must be infallible. Christ's profound love for the Church is manifested in the doctrine of papal infallibility, which asserts that the **pope is preserved by God from error when teaching on matters of faith and morals**. How does this show Christ's love for us? He didn't want to leave His Church in darkness! He wanted His doctrines to be consistent so His people could be guided by truth. The core of papal infallibility is faithfulness to Christ. All of the Catholic Church's teachings are Christocentric—they point toward Christ, who is at the center of her teachings. That is why the Catholic Church doesn't change her doctrines to adjust to the changes in society and culture. The pope helps to uphold and preserve the teachings of Christ. Jesus Himself promised us, **“I am with you always, to the close of the age” (Matthew 28:20)**. To make true His promise, Christ gifted the Church with an unbroken line of popes for 2,000 years, teaching with the papal infallibility that Christ bestowed on their office.

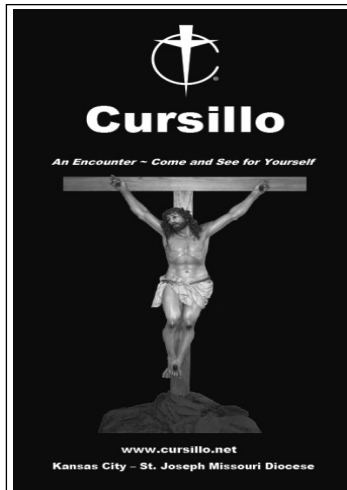
